Subject:- Pre-bid meeting held at Police Headquarters J&K Srinagar on 03.07.2018 in connection with e-NIT No. 23 of 2018 dated 23.06.2018, floated for purchase of 50 nos. Bullet-Resistant Bunkers.

As per contents of e-NIT no. 23 of 2018 dated 23.06.2018, a Pre-bid Conference was held at Police Headquarters J&K Srinagar on 03.07.2018.

All the intending Tenderers are hereby notified about the outcome report of the Pre-bid Conference, **which is mentioned below**. The said outcome report of Pre-Bid meeting shall mutatis mutandis form part of the said e-NIT and deemed to be an amendment to the e-NIT wherever applicable. The other terms & conditions of the e-NIT shall remain unchanged.


S.No.	Contents of the queries	Amendments to e-NIT
1.	Roof Hatch/Turret	There will be one 360 degree rotatable Roof Hatch with complete turret for weapon in Bunker.
2.	Gun Ports	The circular firing/gun ports are to be provided on vehicle body of Bunker.
3.	Delivery Period.	The Technically qualified Tenderer/s have to deliver prototype BP Bunker within 45 days after issuance of Supply order and remaining 49 BP Bunkers within 180 days from the date of Supply Order.
4.	Providing of DIPP License	The firms which have Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) license duly obtained from Govt. of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry can only participate in the e-tender, which is mandatory as per rules.
5.	EMD	The intending Tenderers will have to upload scanned copy of Earnest Money Deposit in the shape of Call Deposit Receipt valid at call or FDR/Bank Guarantee valid till 30.06.2019, from any nationalized Bank/State owned Banks, for an amount of Rs. 50,00,000/= (Rupees Fifty Lakh only) , pledged to AIG (Provision-Transport) PHQ J&K, with the tender offer.

6.	Providing of other Certificates	The approved supplier shall have to provide Certificates, as per Central Motor vehicle rules (CMVR) from Government Laboratory VRDE/ARAI for roadworthiness of vehicles, transparency of BR Glasses and Registration of the vehicles by Transport Department J&K.
7.	Warranty	(a) The supplier will provide a warranty of 30,000 Kms or three years whichever is earlier for Automobile and 10 years for BP and Mine resistant metal/composite material parts and 05 years for BP Glass for BP properties. (b) Supplier will submit a Certificate from the accredited labs to the effect that the BP/MR Glass has got a minimum visibility of 70%.The firm will have to guarantee that in case the visibility of the BP Glass does become less than 70% within a period of 3 year without the glass having suffered any visible mechanical damage, the firm will replace the BP glass free of cost. (c) Firm will give guarantee for making services, fast moving and essential spares/accessories available for at least 10 years from date of purchase.
8.	Technical Specification of base vehicle	The generic technical specification has been given in Tender Notice. However desirable power to weight ratio is 25 BHP/Ton or 18.65 KW/Ton (excluding running load imposed by HVAC System)
9.	Workmanship	The BR Bunker body has to be fabricated with the high quality of workmanship. Welding, laser cutting, fitting, painting etc have to be done with a high quality of workmanship. Sealing compound has to be applied wherever there are holes, gapes etc. All sharp edges etc have to be removed. Cutting of steel has to be done by Laser cutting or Water Jet Cutting, wherever required.
10.	Side Mine Blast Protection.	The successful tenderer has to provide a Certificate to the effect that 'BP Bunker shall withstand the Side Mine Blast' at the time of delivery of BP Bunkers.
11.	Air Conditioner	HVAC System (Heat and Cool) of adequate rating with 2 vents in the Cab (for driver and co-driver) and 6 vents at back (equally spaced) for the troops.
12.	Maintenance during Warranty and Post-Warranty Period	1. The accessories / fitments / spares and technical expertise of automobile should be easily available in J&K State at various places. 2. Manufacturer or Supplier of the BP Bunkers must have its own setup, field repair, maintenance repair and major repair facility in J&K. 3. The vendor will be bound by a condition in the contract that he is in a position to provide Product Support in terms of service and Maintenance, Materials and essential Spares for a minimum

		<p>period of 10 years. Even after the said mandatory period, the vendor would be bound to give at least two years notice to the Police Department J&K prior to closing the production line so as to enable a life time buy of all spares before closure of the said production line.</p> <p>4. The Vendor will be bound to following Timeline for Repair. In case the approved supplier fails to get the vehicle repaired during the time limit, department will impose penalty (at its absolute discretion), which shall be at least equivalent to the cost, the department shall have to bear on getting the vehicles repaired from other sources:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) Field Repair: 07 Days</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) Major Repairs: 01 Month</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(Excluding the time consumed in transit)</p> <p>5. The supplier should be in a position for after Sales Service and Training of Officers/ Drivers / operators on site after BP Bunkers are supplied as and when the supplier is asked for the same.</p>
13.	Emission Norms	Bharat Stage IV standard compliant or better. Noise level may be as per prevailing CMVR norms to suit the essential requirement of BP Bunker.
14.	Provision of Fire extinguishers	The supplier has to provide 02 nos. Fire Extinguishers.
15.	Provision of First Aid Box/Stretchers	The supplier has to provide a foldable light weight stretcher and a First Aid Box in Bunker.
16.	Provision of Rear View Camera and mirror	Rear View Mirrors with appropriate Cameras are to be installed in the Bunker.
17.	Provision for fitting of communication system	There should be provision of a holding of Radio communication sets and Antenna.
18.	Provision and space for ladder, shackles and Axes	There should be provision and space for ladder, shackles and Axes in BP Bunker
19.	Fire Resistant Paint	Fire resistant paint on the exterior of the BP bunker has to be used to prevent burning from petrol and incendiary bomb.
20.	Provision for extra support for suspension	There should be provision for extra support for suspension in the shape of Hydraulic shock absorbers etc. for on road stability of spare parts/BR material used in the vehicle.
21.	Special Tool Kits	The supplier has to provide special tool kits such as Tow Pin, D-Shackles, Recovery Hooks, Compatible Hydraulic Jack etc with each Bunker.
22.	Training of Man Power	The Successful manufacturer will have to arrange free training programme for drivers/operators of Bunker at the location of the Department. One course of four weeks duration on operational capability, working and maintenance and another

		course of eight weeks duration on field/base level repairs/maintenance of Bunker to be provided.
23.	Prototype BP Bunker	The successful tenderer has to fabricate one Prototype BP Bunker, which has to be provided to J&K for inspection/trials. The sample vehicle will be subjected to run for at least 1200 Kms. The cost of such trials to be borne by the manufacturer/supplier of the vehicle. The supplier has to bullet-proof remaining 49 BP Bunkers, after approval of prototype BP bunker.
24.	Automatic demisters	Automatic demisters must be provided with the BR vehicles.
25.	Wire Mesh	Wire Mesh on windscreen and glass panels should be provided.
