ADVERTISEMENT NOTICE

Applications as per enclosed proforma are invited from the permanent residents of J&K State for their recruitment as **Prosecuting Officers** in J&K Police against the vacancies as detailed below in the Pay Band-2 of Rs.9300-34800+ Grade Pay of Rs. 4280/- with fixed salary for the first five years in terms of Govt Order No. 257-F of 2011 dated 27.10.2011 read with SRO 332 of 2011 dated 28.10.2011:-

2- The educational qualification, age and physical standards prescribed for the abovementioned post are specified as under:-

I	Educational Qualification	The candidate should have minimum qualification of Bachelors Degree in Law with minimum of 50% marks obtained from recognized University after undergoing a regular course of study in Law for three years after graduation or five years after 10+2.	
II	Age (as on Jan, 1 st 2012)	Candidates should not be less than 18 years and not more than 28 years of age. (The candidates born before 01-01-1984 and after 31.12.1993 shall not be eligible).	
III	Physical Standard	Male	Female
		Height = 5'-6" (minimum) Chest = 33 ½"(expanded)	Height = 5'-2" (minimum)
		For candidates belonging to Ladakh region and Gorkha community	
		Height = 5'-4" (minimum) Chest = 33 ½"(expanded)	Height = 5" (minimum)

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3- The application forms should be accompanied by attested copies of the following certificates:-

- i) Date of Birth Certificate (Matriculation).
- ii) Higher Academic Qualification Certificate.
- iii) Certificate of Degree in Law from a Recognized University.
- iv) State Subject Certificate(PRC)
- v) Reserved category certificate (if applicable).
- vi) Four copies of recent passport size photograph.
- vii) One self addressed envelope of 28cm x 12 cm size affixed with required postal stamps.

4- Candidates possessing basic eligibility criteria viz age and educational qualification as prescribed here-in-above shall be subjected to the following tests:-

A)	<u>Physical Standard Test(PST)</u>	The test shall be qualifying in nature and no marks are allotted for these tests.
B)	<u>Written Examination</u> (only for the candidates who qualify the physical standard test)	100 marks.
C)	<u>Viva-Voce/Personality Assessment Test</u> (The number of candidates to be called for viva-voce shall be in the ratio of 1:3 i.e. three candidates for each vacancy plus those additional candidates who have secured marks equal to the last candidate in the respective categories.)	20 marks

5- The application forms should be deposited in the following offices under proper receipt:-

- i) Armed Range Police Office(AROK), PCR Srinagar
(for candidates belonging to Kashmir Province).
- ii) Armed Range Police Office(AROK), APHQ Complex Jammu.
(for candidates belonging to Jammu Province).
- iii) SSP District Leh(for candidates belonging to Leh district).
- iv) SSP District Kargil(for candidates belonging to Kargil district).

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Note:-

i) *Application forms incomplete in any manner or not filled up properly shall be rejected.*

ii) *The migrant candidates presently settled out of the Valley who intend to apply, shall deposit their application forms, indicating their original residential particulars, in the offices as quoted above where they are presently settled.*

6. THE LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FORMS AT THE OFFICES AT MENTIONED IN PARA 5 ABOVE IS **31-01-2013**.

7. DIsGP Armed Kashmir/Jammu, SSP Leh/Kargil shall maintain record of all such applications received from the candidates in the prescribed registers for onward submission to the Recruitment Board before the recruitment process starts. While doing so, these offices shall ensure checking of original testimonials of each candidate particularly date of birth, minimum educational qualification and Category Certificate(if any) and reflect same distinctly in the same recruitment register. In case of migrant candidates separate records shall be maintained.

8. Candidates already in Government service and conforming to the above standards can also apply through proper channel after obtaining NOC from their employers without which the application will not be entertained.

9. Candidates who have obtained any loan/stipend under the self-employment scheme or any other category will be allowed to join only in case they obtain a clearance certificate from the concerned department/bank to the effect that they have refunded the loan/cleared any other liability.

10. The candidates shall have to appear in the prescribed tests at their own expenses on the date and venue to be communicated by the Police Recruitment Board, through press and electronic media.

11- In case it is found at any stage of recruitment that the candidate was not eligible for the post, his/her candidature shall be summarily rejected without entering into correspondence with the concerned candidate(s).

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12- The selected candidates shall be subjected to prescribed medical examination/ checkup through Standing Medical Boards and the appointment orders would be issued only subject to receipt of satisfactory report/ clearance about character/ antecedents from CID Headquarters.

13- The selected candidates shall be required to undergo the prescribed Basic Training Course of Prosecuting Officers at SKPA Udhampur.

14- This is issued without prejudice to outcome in writ petition(s), if any, pending before the Competent Courts of Law.
