Subject: e-tendering.

Pursuant to Judgement of Hon'ble High Court of J&K in OWP No. 1629/2016 Finance Department Government of Jammu & Kashmir has vide Order No. 162-FD of 2018 dated 28-03-2018 (Copy enclosed) ordered, "that all the departments shall compulsorily tender all works/procurements costing more than ₹. 1.00 Lakh through e-tendering."

2. In this context attention is invited to Police Headquarters Circular instructions issued vide endorsement No. PHQ/Prov-II/e-proc/2017/8131-90 dated 30-01-2017 where under all the Drawing & Disbursing Officers were directed to register their offices with the e-procurement application of the National Informatics Centre and start e-tendering for works/procurements.

3. However nothing has been heard from the subordinate formations so far. In this regard all the DDOs of J&K Police Department are hereby directed to **forthwith** register their offices on the e-tendering website of Government of J&K and start issuing tenders on the website for works/procurement for ₹. 1.00 Lakh or more.

4. Moreover, it has often been observed that documents related to procurements submitted for accord of sanction by State Level Purchase Committee are incomplete, based on dasti quotations, prepared in casual manner and without specific recommendations of the unit Purchase Committee.

5. In this regard all the subordinate formations are directed to ensure that for effecting purchases proper tendering process with adequate publicity as required under the Financial Code is followed and technical requirements/rates are properly authenticated. Afterwards the complete set of documents may be submitted to PHQ in original (which shall be subsequently returned back) with specific recommendations certifying reasonability of rates by the DDO for further course of action at PHQ level.

6. The instructions shall be followed in letter and spirit.

Subject: OWP No. 1629/2016 titled Ravinder Singh and Others Vs State and Others. Change in limits for e-tendering.

Government Order No. ~~162~~-FD of 2018

Dated:- 28-3-2018

Whereas Information Technology Department had issued circular vide No. 04/ITD of 2015 dated 20-05-2015 urging the departments to tender compulsorily all works/procurements costing more than Rs. 1.00 lakh through e-tendering.

Whereas executing departments had expressed difficulties in the implementation of this downward threshold limit of Rs. 1.00 lakh in view of the prolonged internet breakdown during the year 2016.

Whereas in the aforesaid context, Finance Department reviewed the downward limit for e-tendering and raised it to Rs. 10.00 lakh vide Circular No. A/21(2003)-Misc-A-531 dated 19-09-2016 with the condition that the limit of Rs 10.00 lakh would remain in force till such time the ceiling is reviewed by Finance Department.

Whereas the above circular instructions were stayed by Hon'ble High Court on petition bearing OWP No. 1629/2016 M P No. 01/2016 titled Ravinder Singh and Others Vs State and Others.

Whereas the Hon'ble High Court disposed of the Writ Petition directing to keep the limit unchanged at Rs 1.00 lakh.

Now therefore, in compliance with the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court and in supersession of Circular No. A/21(2003)-Misc-A-531 dated 19-09-2016, it is ordered that all the departments shall compulsorily tender all works/procurements costing more than Rs. 1.00 lakh (one lakh only) through e-tendering.
