An attestation-cum-passing out parade was held in Sher-i-Kashmir Police Academy Udhampur on June 05, 2009 in which 61 probationary officers comprising of 31 Deputy Superintendents of Police, one Inspector and 29 Sub-Inspectors of Police were administered oath of allegiance after successful completion of their training.
