### A LEADING AND DECISIVE ROLE FOR J&K POLICE : DGP

In an interview to the press on March 14, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, said that J&K Police was inflicting decisive blows to militancy and a befitting reply will be given to militants irrespective of the outfit they belong to. Evaluating the performance of J&K Police in the year 1998-99, he expressed satisfaction, both with regard to strengthening the police infrastructure and on the operational role of the police. The police manpower increased substantially so also the requisite logistic support in communication, transport, firearms etc., the DGP added. Giving an account of achievements, the DGP elaborated that the Special Operations Groups were set up even at the sub-divisional and lower levels to give greater teeth to the police effort. A sustained and determined effort was made to motivate the police station staff in the fight against militancy and these efforts have borne fruits. The Armed Police Battalions, which were mainly located at Jammu and Srinagar, were relocated in the militancy infested areas and put to operations along with the district police. Liaison with the security forces has become closer and result oriented. Information leading to some of these operations is being provided by the district police and the Special Operations Groups.

The DGP further stated that J&K Police will live up to the expectations of the public and make every effort towards restoration of peace in the state. Adequate emphasis will be given to eliciting support of the people in this fight.

Earlier, Director General of Police announced on March 11, setting up of more STF pickets in the far-flung and vulnerable areas of Doda and Udhampur district for effectively facing the challenges of residual militancy. The DGP said that a Battalion of J&K Armed Police had been deployed in vulnerable areas of Gool Gulabgarh area of district Udhampur and this Battalion will associate closely with anti-militancy operations in this area.

The DGP complimented Doda police for its major successes in anti-militancy operations in which during last 9 months 65 militants, including 14 foreigners, were killed while 22 were arrested and 23 surrendered before police and security forces. During the same period 90 AK Rifles, 6 UMGs, 6 SLRs, 32

Pistols, 1 Sniper rifle, 1 Carbine and 143 Grenades were also recovered in the district.

### MASS CONTACT PROGRAMME

After having consolidated its position on anti-militancy front, the J&K Police has embarked on a mass contact programme with a view to seek active cooperation from the public to combat crime and fight against militancy.

As part of Police -Public mass contact programme, a series of meetings with the public were held across the state. Such meeting were started in pursuance to the directions of Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police J&K, to listen to the grievances of the public and to redress them by taking

effective measures. The participants in such meetings appreciated the idea of such interactions leading to association of citizens in crusade against crime. In this regard a series of meetings were addressed by Shri Ram Lubhaya, DIG Doda-Udhampur, Shri K. Rajendra, DIG Poonch-Rajouri and district SsP in Jammu province.

### GOODWILL TOUR CONCLUDES

### POLICE OFFICERS TRANSFERRED

State Government issued transfer and posting orders of senior Police officers on March 19. Shri Vijay Raman, IGP Security was repatriated back to his parent cadre, Madhya Pradesh. Shri M.S. Wani, IGP State Human Rights Commission was posted

as IGP Security. Shri S.S. Oberoi, who had recently been promoted as IGP, was posted as IGP State Human Rights Commission. Shri S.K. Sinha, who had reported to the state on deputation, was posted as DIG Security and Shri P.K. Gupta has moved to Vigilance Organisation. Shri Gopal Reddy will be the new DIG of Armed Police, Kashmir.

### A SPECIAL DRIVE BY TRAFFIC POLICE

To check the menace of wrong parking on the roads, intersections and crossings, a special drive was launched by the traffic Police in the city of Jammu. During the month of March, as many as 518 erring drivers, who were found picking and alighting the passengers at unauthorised places, were challaned. Drivers of 2672 vehicles were booked for wrong parking and 494 vehicles were lifted with the help of cranes which were causing inconvenience and obstruction to smooth flow of traffic.

## MAJOR SUCCESSES IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS :

★ In a joint operation launched by Special Operations Group of J&K Police and security forces in Bawan forest area of Zachaldar (Handwara) on March 17, five foreign mercenaries were killed. 3 AK rifles, one pika gun, one sniper rifle, 22 magazines, 712 rounds, 53 detonators, 23 hand grenades and 24 Kgs of explosives were recovered from the place of encounter.

★ On March 20, in a search operation launched by the special operation group of J&K Police, 2 militants of Harkat-ul-Ansar militant outfit were killed during an exchange of fire. One AK rifle was recovered from the spot.

★ During a search operation, Special Operations Group of J&K Police recovered 30 Kg of RDX in village Khayar, Aishmuqam (Anantnag) on March 4.

★ A self styled platoon commander of Lashkar-e-Toiba surrendered before J&K Police in Kupwara district on March 15 with one AK Rifle, 3 magazines and 90 rounds.

★ Special Operations Group of J&K Police killed a foreign mercenary in an encounter at village Theroo, Lar, Ganderbal on March 16. One pika gun was recovered from the slain militant.

★ Self styled Dy. Commander of Hizbul-Mujahideen namely Gulzar Ahmed was killed in an encounter with Special Operations Group of J&K Police on March 30 in Anantnag. One AK rifle, 2 magazines and one grenade launcher were recovered from the site of encounter.

★ On March 31, a hideout located in Chaka forests of Bhandarwah was smashed by Special Operations Group of J&K Police with the assistance of security forces and a cache of weapons/ammunition recovered.
