S. Manjeet Singh, Dy.SP, Hqrs. Poonch and H.C Manohar Lal Sharma attained martyrdom in a suicidal terrorist attack near bus stand, Poonch, on March 14. The martyred Dy.SP and the H.C were accompanying the Moharram procession in Poonch town.

A KPS officer of 1999 batch, late Dy.SP S. Manjeet Singh's love for the motherland was tremendous. He used to tell his batch mates that it would be a great proud for him and his family if he dies while saving the lives of innocent persons. He had vowed to fight terrorists to finish and sacrificed his life for a cause.

The body of the great son of the soil, late Dy.SP S.Manjeet Singh was cremated with full state honours at Shastri Nagar (Jammu) cremation ground on March 15. Shri Mulla Ram,
