POP AT 5. FAITHINANDAN SINGH (SPS) POLICE TRAINING SCHOOL KATHUA

Attestation-cum-passing out parade of 14th batch of 844 recruit constables of J&K Police was held at SPS Police Training School, Kathua, on March 24. Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, who was the Chief Guest, inspected the parade and took salute at an impressive march-past by the contingents of recruit constables.

In his address to jawans and officers, the Chief Minister said that the people have high expectations from the Police, who are entrusted with the task of protecting the lives, property and the honour of the masses. 
