WITH CO-OPERATION OF THE PEOPLE, J&K POLICE WILL STEER THE STATE TO PEACE AND NORMALCY: DGP

Welcoming the Chief Minister, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, at the Passing-out Parade (POP) of the 2nd batch of J&K Police recruit constables (755), at Subsidiary Training Centre (STC), Sheri, Baramulla, on July 23, the DGP, J&K, Shri A.K. Suri, said that

the J&K Police, undeterred by the harsh circumstances and challenges, shall remain in the vanguard to combat militancy till its finish. "With the co-operation of the people, the force will steer the state to peace and normalcy", DGP added. The DGP also expressed gratitude to the Chief Minister for taking personal interest in strengthening the police force.

Speaking at the function, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, J&K, congratulated the recruits for their successful completion of basic training and enviable turn-out and urged them to abide by the pledge taken during "Oath Ceremony". He reminded the recruits of their bounden duty to protect the lives of the citizens without any consideration of religion, caste and creed. He gave them a piece of advice- "Be friends of people and never consider yourself as masters". He assured the Police personnel that every step shall be

taken for their welfare and mitigating difficulties.

Earlier, the Chief Minister took salute at an impressive march-past and also inspected the parade.

The chief Minister gave away the prizes and certificates to the recruits, who had excelled in various subjects during their training. The recipients of prizes and certificates were constable Bilal Ahmed, Constable Lal Din and Constable Shabir Ahmed, who got first three positions respectively in outdoors; Constable Manzoor Hussain, Constable Mohd Saleem and Constable Bag Singh, who were adjusted 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively in indoors; Constable Lal Din Pathan, Constable Abid Hussain and Constable Nisar Ahmed who got first three positions respectively in range classification.

Constable Mohd Saleem, who was declared as around best recruit, was promoted out of turn to the rank of Selection Grade Constable.

CHANGING FACE OF J&K POLICE.

Civic action programme, launched by the police in J&K state, a step towards strengthening the police-public ties, has shown in ample measure that J&K Police is not only combating insurgency and maintaining law and order but is also fully involved in fulfilling the socio-economic urges of the people of the state, by mobilising its resources.

J&K police has launched "Civic Action Programme" across the state and civic amenities/facilities are being provided under the following categories:-

- Establishing youth clubs and vocational training centres;
- Construction of recreation Halls/ community centres, drinking water tanks, *Saraies*, bath-rooms, toilet blocks, passengers sheds, road strips (bridal paths);
- Providing School uniforms, books and stationery items to the poor and needy;
- Organising tour programmes for school children;
- Sponsoring sports tournaments;
- Holding of seminars and free medical camps, and
- Promotion of cultural activities.

Under the programme, J&K Police in collaboration with Composite Regional Centre, Government of India, Srinagar, started an artificial limb camp from July, 30, in Srinagar. While Composite Regional Centre (CRC) provides limbs to disabled persons free of cost upto a fixed income ceiling, the J&K Police provides artificial limbs free of cost, to all the needy persons, irrespective of their economic status.

Similar artificial limb camps are being held in the border districts of Poonch and Rajouri in the coming days.

The Artificial Limb Camp was inaugurated by Shri M. A. Lone (MOS) Home, J&K, and Shri B.A. Kitchloo, Minister for Social Welfare, was the Chief Guest at the said function. The Director General of Police, Shri A. K. Suri, DGP, Homeguards & Civil Defence, Shri A. C. Chaturvedi, ADGP, Armed, Shri Gopal Sharma, ADGP, CID, Shri Kuldeep Khoda, IGP, Kashmir, Dr. Ashok Bhan, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, Shri Khurshid A. Ganai, and several other senior police and civil officers were present on the occasion.
