POP OF KPS OFFICERS AT SK POLICE ACADEMY

An impressive POP of 74 Probationary Dy SsP, including three women officers, was held at SK Police

Academy, Udhampur, on July 06. Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister J&K, who was the Chief Guest at the passing out-cum-attestation Ceremony, took salute and inspected the Parade.

Addressing the officers and jawans, the Chief Minister lauded the role of J&K police and said that with the sincere efforts of Sh. Gurbachan Jagat, DGP, the state police has improved a lot and its well functioning has been

acknowledged by the Home Ministry at the Centre also. The need of the hour is to build J&K Police and to make it a best force, with high professional skills and trained in Commando action so that it can fight out militancy effectively, he added. He called upon the passing out batch of officers, who were Commando trained, to get ready for major offensive against the Pak-trained militants. Cautioning police personnel against Human Right Violations, the Chief Minister said that senior police officers should ensure that innocent people are not harassed or victimised and those responsible for HR violations should be punished.

Appreciating the role of SOG, the CM said that the recent actions against militants in Poonch reveal that J&K police has turned highly professional and bold in taking edge over militants. He also stressed the need for co-operation among Army, Para-military forces and the police in carrying out anti-militancy operations.

Earlier, Sh. Gurbachan Jagat, DGP, disclosed that highly trained Commando battalions, to fight out militancy in the state, are in the making. The quality and capacity of training has been improved a lot and new curricula, according to the requirements introduced, in the training institutes, the DGP added.

Director, Sher-e-Kashmir Police Academy, Sh. Masud Choudhary, IGP, read out the annual report and highlighted the achievements during his welcome address.

MAJOR SUCCESSES IN ANTI MILITANCY

- ★ Three dreaded militants including a Pak national were arrested by Border Police, Jammu at Sapwal (Samba) on July 06. A cache of weapons and ammunition was recovered at the instance and disclosure of arrested militants.
- ★ Srinagar Police recovered 70 kgs. RDX at Badademb (Srinagar) on July 18.
- ★ SOG, Kupwara, with backup from a contingent of security forces, eliminated Abu-Khalil Ayubi of Muzaffarabad, launching Chief of LET, Sher Dil Gujjar of Sialkot (PAK), launching chief of Al-Badar and his deputy, Abu Bilal of Sialkot (PAK) in Kupwara forests on July 21.
- ★ SOG Baramulla, in a joint operation with security forces, eliminated 2 foreign mercenaries in Kreeri area of Pattan on July 21.
- ★ Border Police Jammu recovered 20kgs. RDX and a cache of explosive devices near village Basantar on July 16.
