### CM APPRECIATES J&K POLICE FOR ITS FIGHT AGAINST MILITANCY

Addressing the officers and the jawans at the passing out parade of 3rd CRTS batch at Police Training School (PTS) Manigam, Srinagar, on Nov. 22, the Chief Minister, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, lauded the J&K Police for its fight against militancy and said that J&K Police is the best suited Police Force and is performing a very difficult job and the role of J&K Police has come in for praise from the Ministries of Home and Defence.

Earlier, the Chief Minister inspected the parade and took salute at the marchpast.

In his welcome address, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, said that due to the efforts of the Chief Minister and the liberal grants sanctioned by the Central Govt, the State Police has been upgraded and modernised. The state police has been strengthened by about 20,000 personnel, existing Police Training Institutes upgraded and logistic support provided to Police Stations and Posts, the DGP added.

Constable Basharat Hussain, who was adjudged as the best allround trainee, was given one rank promotion on the spot.

### SHRI A. K. SURI IS THE NEW DGP

Shri A. K. Suri (1969, RR - J&K) took over as Director General of Police, J&K on Nov. 29. Shri Suri has rich experience and long association with J&K Police in various capacities. He has worked as DIG Counter Intelligence, IGP Kashmir and Jammu Zones, ADGP Law and Order and ADGP CID in J&K Police. He is the recipient of Police Medal for meritorious services and President's Police Medal for distinguished services.

Addressing officers and staff of Police Hqrs., soon after taking over as Director General of Police, the new Police Chief said that the State is passing through a crucial juncture and the Police would have to strive harder to achieve the goal of restoration of normalcy. He called upon the Police Officers to have greater interaction with the people and to make sincere efforts

Restoration of peace and putting an end to militancy should be our main agenda, he added.

### MY DAYS AT KOSOVO - Rakesh Dhar, DySP Telecom, J&K

Boarding a Chartered flight of UN on Dec. 03, 99, at Indira Gandhi International Airport. New Delhi, I landed at Military Airport of Nato at Skopje capital of Macedonia, where the temperature was sub-zero. I reached Pristina from Skopje and it was just two hours drive in a cozy bus. *Sh. The group of which I was a member comprised of 87 officers from India. During my stay in Pristana, I received the basic induction training. During our training, Pakistani Officers, deployed on UN Peace keeping mission, were quite hospitable and their behaviour was very nice. They would visit us regularly in the evenings and give us all tit-bits and also the Do's and DONT's which proved very useful during our stay in Ksovo.

All the five officers from J&K (01 SP, 02, DySP and 02 inspectors) were deployed in Gjilan region. One of the officers remained at Gjilan as traffic officer while 4 including me were deputed to Police station. Kamenica, which was located near the border of Serbia. The station commander of this Police Station was an American and the station was manned by just 13 when we arrived there and the strength of this Police station was more than 100 when we left.

I, alongwith other 4 members from J&K performed duties as Patrol Officer, Traffic Officer, Investigator, Duty Officer and Shift Supervisor.

The Police functioning in Kosovo is on the pattern of America. Patrols are required to take initial reports (FIRs) and pass it on to the Investigating Officers for the purpose of investigation. in cases of shooting in air, possession of illegal arms and arson etc. Heinous offences like homicide vehicular accidents involving human life, robbery and rape etc. were dealt by the Regional Investigation Unit. Offences of cow theft and domestic violence were quite frequently reported and were dealt with by the Patrols.

Even a minor traffic violation is not allowed to go unnoticed. By an large the people have a better traffic sense.

### RAISING DAY OF JKAP VI BN

On Nov. 17, JKAP 6th Bn. located at Nagri (Doda) celebrated its 20th Raising Day. A ceremonial parade was held as part of the impressive function which was attended by Senior Police Officers and large number of Policemen and other prominent citizens of district. Shri P.R. Gandotra, DIG Armed Police, Jammu was the Chief guest on the occasion.

## HIGH LIGHTS OF ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS

- SOG Jammu worked out Fidayeen attack on the pilgrims of August 01, 2000 by arresting 4 militants identified as Tariq, Imran Qazi, Faisal Muneer and Assadullah Malik.
- In a joint operation, SOG and Rashtriya Rifles eliminated a foreign mercenary near Battal Wali (Rajouri) on Nov. 08.
- In a joint operation Romeo Force and SOG Poonch eliminated two foreign mercenaries of TJI near Dhara Sangla village in Surankote on Nov 05. The slain militants were identified as Rahim Dar and Zahid, both residents of POK.
- Doda Police gunned down 4 hardcore militants of Hizbul Mujahideen outfit including Liaqat Bilouch, District Commander of the said outfit, in an encounter in village Dariya in Doda district on Nov. 06.

- SOG, Doda, eliminated 4 militants including hardcore militant namely Saddam Hussain, a Pakistani National at Village Batwagan, Doda on Nov. 12.

- On Nov. 01, on a tip off, Special Operations Group Budgam and Army eliminated 3 hardcore militants of Jaish-e-Mohammad militant outfit at village Nadipora, district Budgam who were later identified as Qari Mohd. Jalil, Mohd Akmal and Mohd Kaleem, all residents of Gujranwalla, Pakistan. In yet another joint operation by Army and Special Operations Group, Kulgam 4 unidentified militants were eliminated at Village Bhadeypora of district Kulgam.
- Lakhapur (Kathua) Police recovered a consignment of arms and ammunition including 2 AK-47 rifles from a fruit laden truck on Nov. 22.
- A foreign mercenary identified as Abu Hassan a Pak National, was eliminated in a joint operation by the Police and the Army in Motha forest in district Doda on Nov. 06.
