### LANDMARK DECISIONS TAKEN DURING 10<sup>TH</sup> CENTRAL POLICE WELFARE COMMITTEE MEETING

10<sup>th</sup> Central Police Welfare Committee Meeting was held at Police Auditorium Gulshan Ground Jammu on December 11, 2010 after a gap of more than seven years. The meeting was attended by a large number of senior police officers and representatives from all police units across the state including Shri K.Rajendra Kumar IPS ADGP Armed/Law & Order J&K, Shri Ram Lubhaya IPS ADGP, Mrs. D.R Doley IPS IGP Hqrs. PHQ J&K, Shri S.Owais Ahmad IPS IGP (Pers & Trg.) PHQ J&K, Shri Naveen Agarwal IPS IGP, Shri A.K Gupta IPS IGP, Shri Mohammad Amin Shah IPS IGP, Shri Z.H Chisthi IPS IGP, Dr. B.Srinivas IPS IGP, Shri Ravinder Kotwal IPS IGP, Shri H.K Lohia IPS IGP, Shri Alok Puri IPS DIG, Shri T.Punchok IPS DIG, Shri Danesh Rana IPS DIG, Dr. Kamal Saini DIG, Shri N.D Wani IPS AIG(P) PHQ, Shri Ali Mohammad IPS AIG (Provision) PHQ and Shri Firdous Iqbal AIG(CIV) PHQ.

After detailed discussions with the representatives of different units of police the following landmark decisions for the benefit of the police personnel were taken :-

1. Retirement gift enhanced from Rs.3000/- to Rs.35,000/- W.e.f December 11, 2010.
2. Special Welfare Relief enhanced from Rs.6.00 lacs to Rs.6.50 lacs w.e.f December 11, 2010. This also includes enhancement of immediate relief from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.25,000/-.
3. Enhanced Powers delegated to Central Police Welfare Committee as well as Zonal, Range and Unit level welfare committees for grant of loan/relief to Police personnel. As per the decision Central Police Welfare committee can now sanction Loan upto Rs.50,000/- and Relief upto Rs.25,000/- whereas Zonal Committee headed by ADGP/IGP as its Chairman can sanction loan upto Rs.25,000/- and Relief upto Rs.3000/-, Range Police Welfare Committee can sanction loan upto Rs.20,000/- and relief upto Rs.2000/- and district/unit police welfare committee can sanction loan upto Rs.15,000/- and Relief upto Rs.1000/-.

4. Introduction of immediate Loan upto Rs.50,000/- for the police personnel suffering from life terminal diseases/emergent cases for treatment outside the state subject to proper referral by Competent Medical Authority.
5. Meritorious Scholarship has been enhanced from existing rate of Rs.840 to Rs.2400 per annum for the wards of serving police personnel securing 75% and above marks in class 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> from the Academic year 2010.
6. Scholarship in favour of the wards of police personnel killed in militancy related incidents has been enhanced from the existing rate of Rs.1800/- to Rs.2400/- per annum up to 5<sup>th</sup> primary.
7. Scholarship in favour of the wards of police personnel killed in militancy related incidents studying in 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> class has been enhanced from the existing rate of Rs.3000/- to Rs.6000/- per annum.
8. Scholarship in favour of the wards of police personnel killed in militancy related incidents studying in 11<sup>th</sup> to Graduation level including wards pursuing diploma in technical courses has been enhanced from the existing rate of Rs.4200/- to Rs.10,000/- per annum.
9. Scholarship in favour of the wards of police personnel killed in militancy related incidents pursuing technical courses of 04 years and above duration has been enhanced from the existing rate of Rs.4800/- to Rs.12,000/- per annum.
10. Scholarship of wards of deceased police personnel (other than wards of martyrs) upto 10<sup>th</sup> class has been enhanced from the existing rate of Rs. 1200/- to Rs.2400/- per annum.
11. DGP Special rewards have been increased from 06 to 12 for the wards of GOs @ 04 rewards each for 10<sup>th</sup>, 10+2 and Graduation level.
12. DGP Special rewards for the wards of NGOs have been increased from 09 to 18 @ 06 rewards each for 10<sup>th</sup>, 10+2 and Graduation level.
13. DGP special rewards for the wards of HCs/ Sgts/Cts/Followers have been increased from 24 to 72 @ 24 rewards each for 10<sup>th</sup>, 10+2 and Graduation level.
14. DGP commendation certificate with cash reward @ Rs. 5000/-, Rs.3000/- and Rs.2000/- will be awarded to the wards of serving police personnel who secure 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> position respectively in National level sports events.
15. Special relief of Rs. 01 lac will be granted to the NOKs of Special Police Officers who expire while in service w.e.f December 11, 2010 out of SPOs contributory fund. The per head subscription of the SPOs has also been enhanced from Rs. 5 to Rs.10/- per month.
16. The expenditure incurred by the SPOs for their treatment in Government Hospitals will be reimbursed.
17. Financial Assistance upto Rs.25,000/- will be granted to SPOs for the treatment of life terminal diseases/serious injuries in emergent cases.
18. Wards of Martyred SPOs will be provided free schooling in J&K Police Public School.
19. Central Police Canteen Facility on the pattern of CSD will be introduced by March 2011.
20. J&K Police Public Schools will be opened at Doda and Rajouri Districts.
21. Police petrol pumps will be established at District level under Police Parivar for providing job opportunities to the wards of police martyrs.
22. Subscriptions towards various welfare funds will be remitted through Net banking.
23. External Audit of welfare accounts will be conducted annually.
24. GPF Accounts of all Police Employees will be consolidated by DDO concerned through Police GPF cells.
25. Police Housing Colonies one each at Srinagar and Jammu will be established.

## PASSING OUT PARADE OF 22<sup>ND</sup> BRTC HELD AT PTS KATHUA
