SUBSIDIARY TRAINING CENTRES ESTABLISHED

The DGP has ordered setting up of two new subsidiary training centres for newly recruited constables of executive police at Talwara (Reasi) and Channi Himmat (Jammu) under the supervision of Shri Satvir Gupta, Commandant IR IV Battalion and Shri G. A. Dar, Commandant JKAP XII Battalion, respectively. About 1300 trainees from various districts of the state have already reported in these centres. 1000 trainees are presently under training at PTS Kathua. About 500 recruit constables will join PTA Udhampur on Dec. 15, 1000 constables at PTS Manigam on Jan. 15 and 1000 reruit constables at PTS Kathua on March 30.

AERODYNAMIC FLYING MACHINES SEIZED BY POLICE.

Working on an input that ISI officials had pushed in sophisticated and modernised weaponry, including air-borne aerodynamic modules for militant activities in J&K, Rajouri Police achieved a break through by interrogating suspected guides and succeeded in recovering two remote controlled flying machines from the hideout of militants in dense forest area at Chiti Deri (Kalakøte) on Nov. 4. One of the boxes containing remote devises

was also seized by the Police. Each object is about 3 1/2 ft. x 2 ft. weighing about 15 Kgs. These remote controlled devises have powerful engines and are estimated to have the capability to hit targets upto Kms, attaining 500 to 600 feet height.

SOG PERSONNEL ACHIEVE MARTYRDOM

On Nov. 24, militants targeted a SOG vehicle of Anantnag with a remote control explosive device while it was negotiating a culvert at Dari Gund, on way to Bijbehara.

The explosive device blew up the Gypsy and 5 SOG personnel got killed on spot and another succumbed to injuries in hospital. The martyred SOG personnel were SI Naresh Kapai, HC Hakim-Ud-Din, onst. Roop Lal, Const. Roshan Lal. Const. Ali Mohammad and Police honours for the late Constable Roop Lal Const. Mohammad Jamal. The deceased police personnel were cremated with full police honours at their respective villages in the presence of senior police officers.

TOP HM MILITANT NABBED IN BATOTE. RDX AND WEAPONS RECOVERED FROM HIM.

Zahoor Ahmad, a militant belonging to Hizbul-Mujahideen outfit, was arrested by Batote Police at village Jathi (Doda). At the disclosure and instance of the arrested militant, police recovered 8 Kgs. Of RDX, 1 AK-56 Rifle, 2 grenades, 4 Magazines 1 Wireless set and a pocket diary containing addresses and telephone contact numbers in Pakistan.

BIG ARMS HAUL BY SOG BUDGAM

Special Operations Group (SOG) of J&K Police, Budgam unearthed a massive arms dump of Hizbul-Mujahideen and recovered a large quantity of weapons and ammunition which

included 7 AK-56 Rifles with 14 Magazines, 7 Hand grenades and 2 Pistols from Potshai forest area in Kupwara on Nov 5. The seized consignment of weapons and ammunition had been lately pushed in through the LAC in Kupwara area.
