### WOMEN POLICE STATIONS FOR JAMMU AND SRINAGAR

Chief Minister, Dr Farooq Abdullah, has announced that capital cities of Jammu and Srinagar will have women Police Stations very soon. He was addressing a women's rally in Jammu on Nov. 27.

Police Hqrs. have already initiated steps to implement the announcement of the Chief Minister. A notification with regard to establishment and jurisdiction of these Police Stations is expected shortly. These police stations will be manned by women police officials. It is proposed that these police stations will have jurisdiction over the entire cities of Srinagar and Jammu to deal with crimes against women including dowry cases.

### DGP TOURS BORDER AREAS

Shri Gurbachan Jagat, DGP J&K, visited border areas of Jammu district on Nov. 6 and 7 to take stock of the security situation and assess the progress in establishing various facilities for the recently established border Police district. Shri Jagat, while touring border villages in R.S.Pura, Ramgarh and Akhnoor sectors, cautioned the people against the designs of anti-national and anti-social elements and sought their cooperation in nabbing them. He assured the people that all steps will be taken to ensure safety of their lives and property. The DGP advised officers to maintain liaison with the people by touring extensively. He gave away cash prizes of Rs. 10,000/- each to 4 villagers of Bardoo in Akhnoor tehsil for helping in anti-militancy operations. SHO Akhnoor, SI Jagjeet Singh, was given a cash reward of Rs. 15,000/- for his remarkable contributions.

Shri Gurbachan Jagat announced that 300 SPOs will be recruited among the youth of border area very soon. He was accompanied by IGP Jammu Zone, Shri Kuldeep Khuda, DIG Jammu, Shri S.K. Mishra and SP Border district, Dr Kamal Saini.

DGP also visited Poonch and Rajouri districts on Nov. 8 to take stock of the counter insurgency operations. While listing measures to strengthen security apparatus, the DGP announced setting up of more

Village Defence Committees and Special Task Force Groups in these border districts. He held separate meetings with prominent citizens, SHOs as well as heads of intelligence agencies. DGP noted with satisfaction the useful work done by SPOs in the border areas.

### EYE CAMP AT POLICE HOSPITAL JAMMU

A ten day eye camp for retired and serving Police personnel and their families was inaugurated by Minister for Health and Medical Education, Dr Mustafa Kamal, in Police Lines, Jammu, on Nov. 24. The Minister lauded the role of Police in fighting militancy and said



that J&K Police had come up to the expectations of the people. He appreciated organising of Eye Camp and announced that 2 ambulances will be provided for Police Hospitals at Jammu and Srinagar from the grants of Health department.

Dr A.K. Bhan, IGP (Modernisation), while welcoming the chief guest and the DGP, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, outlined the purpose behind the Eye Camp and the plans of the department to improve medical facilities for their personnel. Dr Sunil Chowdhary, Medical Superintendent of Police Hospital, proposed a vote of thanks.

Shri Gurbachan Jagat, DGP, Shri S.S. Ali, Addl.DGP Armed Police, Director, Health Services, Head of the Department of Ophthalmology, Chief Medical Officer, Jammu and senior Police and civil officers were present on the occasion.

727 patients were examined and 225 individuals provided spectacles free of cost by the Welfare Branch of Police Hqrs. 40 eye operations were carried out by Dr Kulrattan Anand and Dr Vinod Gupta and operated patients were provided free spectacles by the District Blindness Society. Shri T. Punchok, AIG(Welfare) monitored the day to day management of the camp on behalf of PHQ.

### SHRI SAGAR VISITS JAMMU BORDER

The Minister of State for Home, Shri Ali Mohd Sagar, lashed at

Pakistan for abetting terrorism in J&K, while addressing a series of meetings in Suchetgarh-R.S.Pura sectors on Nov. 1. He disclosed that 300 SPOs will be recruited from Suchetgarh-R.S.Pura belt and reiterated the determination of the popular Government to ensure safety of lives and property of the people living on the border. In this regard the creation of border police district had brought a marked improvement in controlling crime, said the minister.

Shri Kuldeep Khuda, IGP Jammu Zone disclosed that 26 trans-border criminals including ISI agents had been arrested in the border belt.

### MAJOR SUCCESS BY BHADERWAH POLICE

Police in Doda district achieved a major success by recovering a huge dump of arms and explosives including 2 Pica guns, 1 sniper rifle, 2 AK rifles, 2 pistols, 12 grenades and a huge quantity of explosives from Bhaderwah on Nov. 21. These recoveries were made at the instance of Manzoor Ahmed @ Arif from a well concealed hideout at Gatha Udrana.

Special Operations Group Kishtwar on Nov. 10, in a quick and swift action killed an HM militant, Ghulam Rasool, during a search operation. 1 Chinese pistol, 2 grenades and ammunition were recovered. Similarly, a top ranking militant of HM Mohd Hanif, involved in the killing of 7 Army Jawans in July 1995, was arrested by a joint team of Bhaderwah Police and CRPF.
