NEW MILLENNIUM TO BRING POLICE CLOSE TO THE PEOPLE : DGP

Shri A.K. Suri, Director General of Police has called upon the officers to intensify police-public mass contact programme in the state. Immediately after he took over as the Director General of Police, he has been continuously persuing his programme to strengthen the ties with general masses, which he firmly believes is sine-qua-nun for the success of police. With this view, the DGP visited several remote places in R.S. Pura, Kathua, Kotranka (Rajouri) and Kunzar (Baramulla) and interacted with the people.

Addressing a gathering at the inaugural ceremony of Police Station Kunzar (Baramulla) on Jan 01, he assured the people that the J&K Police shall reach out to them with a human face; and sought their cooperation in return. With a view to follow-up the mass-contact programme, a number of measures have been taken which include:-

- Formulation of a schedule for holding police-public meets regularly at sub-divisional, Districts, Range and Zonal levels. During the course of meetings, problems of the people will be heard and efforts made to solve them.

- Where a problem is brought to the notice of police officer which is not within his competence to solve, he shall forward the same to the competent authority for solution and follow up results.
- The Director General of Police shall be directly dealing with the complaints/grievances and no intermediate official would be scrutinizing such written complaints/grievances. For this, complaint boxes are being installed.

BOAT RACE IN DAL LAKE - A FRIENDLY MISSION OF J&K POLICE:-

Under the mass contact programme, "Chillai Kalan Nav race" (a boat race in chill season) was organised by the Srinagar police in the Dal Lake on Jan 15. The response to the said boat race was overwhelming and such was the eagerness and inclination for participation on the part of the youth of the area that the competition had to be spread over several heats to accommodate all. 56 teams had participated in various competitions. A large number of the people thronged the venue, braving the chill. The event provided an opportunity for close interaction between the police and the Dal people.

Police, were felicitated by Shri A.K. Suri, DGP J&K, at PCR Jammu on Jan 07, after their return.

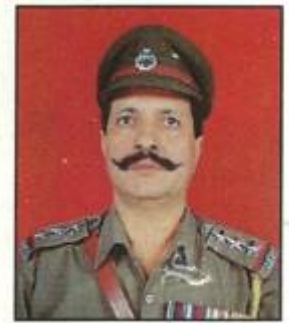

SJM GILLANI IS NEW AIG(P) PHQ, J&K

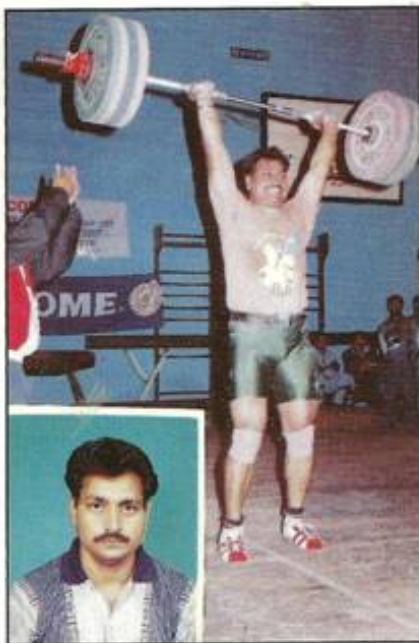
In a major reshuffle in J&K Police, Home department issued transfer orders of 45 Superintendents of Police on Jan 19 which include the following:-

SI DALJEET SINGH - A PROMISING COP OF J&K POLICE

SI Daljeet Singh of J&K Police won yet another medal in the recently held Senior National Weightlifting Championship at Vishakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, (Jan 17-21) and completed the tally of ten medals to his credit. He lifted 310 Kg weight in the heavy weight group to finish third and clinched Bronze medal.

Daljeet Singh started his career as a weightlifter in 1991 and won his first medal in Junior National Championship at Lucknow. In the year 1993, he won four medals (3 silver and one bronze) in the Junior National Championship which was held in Andhra Pradesh. He won a medal in Senior National Championship (Chennai-1997) and also a silver medal in National Games, Bangalore, the same year.

MAJOR SUCCESSES IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS:-

Interstate network of Jamaat-ul-Mujahidin (JUM) outfit was busted by Srinagar Police in the first week of January by arresting six militants from Srinagar and Kolkata (W.B). Those arrested from Srinagar were identified as Muzafar Mirza, Chief Commander and coordinator of the outfit, Khursheed Ahmed @ Alam Khan, Dy. District Commander, Mohd. Sultan Islahai

and Abdul Aziz Peer. Those arrested from Kolkata were identified as Nissar Ahmed Gandroo and Zahoor Ahmed.

- Four dreaded foreign mercenaries of Lashker-e-Toiba (LeT) outfit were gunned down by police and Army in an encounter at village Morah Bachchai in Surankote area of Poonch district on January 27. Three of the slain militants were identified as Muzafar Ahmed of Mirpur (POK), Kari Abdullah and Ziaur-Qamar @ Danni, both Pak Nationals.
- Two militants, identified as Hafiz Abu Sanam Hamid @ Usman, were eliminated in an encounter with RR & SOG at Wongipora, Sumbal, Ganderbal on 28-01-2001.
- Jammu police assisted by Army and CRPF gunned down six dreaded foreign mercenaries at village Kalakam near Bathera in Mishriwala area on January 21.
- Three foreign mercenaries of Lashker-e-Toiba (LeT) were killed in two encounters with Army and Police at village Morian in Ghambir area of Manjkot Police Station in Rajouri district on January 24.
- SOG Doda, with the backup of RR Jawans, gunned down a dreaded militant, identified as Hamid Bhat @ Gazi, Tehsil Commander of HM outfit at village Bogari in Kastigarh area of Doda District on Jan 22.
- Two militants, identified as Abdul Rashid and Mohd. Ashraf Dar, both belonging to HM outfit, were gunned down by Special Operation Group (SOG) Kulgam and BSF at village Srundho (Kulgam) on January 22.
