An outline of action plan, spelling out the wide variety of areas, aimed at promoting the well being of *Jawan*, was given out by the DGP at a meeting of senior officers held at the PHQ. - ◆ Speedy disposal of pending ex-gratia payment cases;
- ◆ Paying adequate attention towards the schooling of wards of Police personnel particularly of the deceased ones;
- ◆ Opening of 2 new schools (10+2) for the wards of the Police personnel, one each at Jammu and Srinagar;
- ◆ Creating and exploring of Employment avenues for the wards of Police personnel;
- ◆ Launching of Special drive to dispose off the pending pension cases;
- ◆ Launching of intensive drive to ensure cleanliness of all Police residential/official premises;
- ◆ Maintenance of Police Housing Colonies;
- ◆ Organising Special medical camps for medical check-up of the *Jawans* and their families;
- ◆ Reimbursement of medical claims;

- ◆ Holding of sports competitions at district/zone/state level;
- ◆ Setting-up of book banks/libraries for the benefit of Police personnel and their wards;
- ◆ Rewarding the wards of Police personnel who excel in their academic pursuits;
- ◆ Holding of special *darbars* at Police Station/District/Company/Battalion level for speedy redressal of the genuine grievances of the *Jawans*;
- ◆ Up dating the entries in GPF Pass books and speedy disposal of GPF cases;
- ◆ Focussing on career opportunities of the *Jawans*;
- ◆ Finalising all pending departmental enquiries expeditiously;
- ◆ Updating the service record of Police personnel; and
- ◆ Focussing on Trainings.
