POLICE'S ROLE VITAL FOR RESTORATION OF NORMALCY IN THE STATE: C.M. J&K

Addressing the officers and *Jawans*, at the Attestation-cum-Passing out Parade (POP) ceremony of 573 recruit constables at Police Training School (PTS), Manigam, on January 04, Mufti Mohammad Sayeed, Chief Minister, J&K, said that the J&K Police has a vital responsibility to carry forward the process of healing the wounds of the people, the process of which has been initiated by the new Government in the state. He exhorted the policemen to win the hearts of the people and stressed on sympathetic and pro-people attitude of the police. He complimented the state police for its performance and recounted the Martyrdom of hundreds of its *Jawans* who lost their lives while performing duty.

In his address, Shri A.K. Suri, DGP, reminded the passing out constables of their responsibilities, as members of vast police family of 60,000 odd, and exhorted them to prove their worth in the field.

POLICE HELPLINES IN SRINAGAR AND JAMMU

Two Helplines have been set up by J&K Police, one each at Jammu and Srinagar on January 17. Working round the clock, the Helplines serve as telephonic call centres to record the complaints and grievances of the public for speedy action/redressal. The Police Helplines have been set up in pursuance to the directions of Chief Minister. The object of establishing the Helplines is to bridge the gap between the common people and the Government. The wide variety of areas in which the public can seek help include:

- ❖ Information about the whereabouts of the person/s picked up by security forces/any agency;
- ❖ Information about the missing persons;
- ❖ Problems related to water scarcity, disruption in power supply etc.; and
- ❖ Law and order problems where Police involvement could be necessary.

The complaint recorded is referred to the concerned quarters expeditiously; followed up vigorously by the Police Helpline and the complainant informed about the action taken /information gathered by calling him back.
