# TRAININGS IN J&K POLICE — THE VISION

To make the J&K Police professionally efficient, competent and updated and in tune with the pace of development, through continuous and innovative training initiatives, the vision centres on:-

- ❖ Building Competence;
- ❖ Improving knowledge and sharpening skills;
- ❖ Cultivating core values of excellence in service delivery;
- ❖ Developing physical fitness and mental alertness;
- ❖ Achieving organizational goals;
- ❖ Strengthening Police- community relations;
- ❖ Honing and moulding the Police personnel into decent human beings, disciplined soldiers and efficient professionals;
- ❖ Making the Force technology receptive; and
- ❖ Developing attitudes in consonance with the concepts of social justice.

With a view to increasing the efficiency of the Armed Police component, the striking force of the Jammu and Kashmir Police, Armed Police Headquarters declared the year 2006 as the "Year of Trainings" for acquiring knowledge and skills on a continuing basis.
