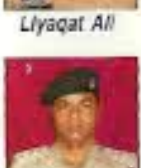

ACHIEVEMENTS IN ANTI MILITANCY OPERATIONS

R.D.X., 30 Detonators, 04 UBGL, 24 UBGL rounds, 01 HMG, 01 mine, 01 Rocket Launcher, 35 Pistol rounds & 40 Pika rounds.
