243 J&K POLICE PERSONNEL HONOURED WITH MEDALS ON REPUBLIC DAY-2009

GOOD NEWS FOR J&K POLICE & CIVILIANS**D.G.'s GOLD MEDAL & D.G.'s SILVER MEDAL INSTITUTED IN J&K POLICE****CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF DGP'S COMMENDATION MEDAL AND CERTIFICATE PARTIALLY MODIFIED CIVILIANS WILL NOW ALSO GET DGP'S MEDAL WITH RS. 10,000/- CASH REWARD FOR EXEMPLARY ACTS**

A scheme for institution of D.G.'s Gold Medal and D.G.'s silver Medal has been instituted in J&K Police and implemented in light of the criteria fixed vide PHQ order No.2842 of 2008 dated 02-09-2008 and PHQ order No.3852 of 2008 dated 30-12-2008.

The Salient features of the scheme for award of D.G.'s Gold and Silver Medal in J&K Police are as under:-

- a) D.G.'s Gold Medal shall be in the shape of an octagon, duly embossed with J&K police Colour and with the inscription "DG J&K POLICE GOLD MEDAL" made of brass as base metal duly gold plated, weighing 15 grams.
- b) Similarly, DG's silver Medal shall be in the shape of an octagon, duly embossed with J&K Police Colour and with the inscription "DG J&K POLICE SILVER MEDAL" made of silver as base metal, weighing 15 grams.
- c) The total number of 30 D.G.'s Silver Medals and 05 D.G.'s Gold Medals will be awarded every year.

**CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF
D.G.'s SILVER MEDAL**

- 1) The individual should be recipient of DG's Commendation Medal, and a period of 05 years must have elapsed since the award of DG's Commendation Medal.
- 2) The individual should have completed 10 years of unblemished service with outstanding/very good grading in the ACR/APR/Annual Remarks, for the last 05 consecutive years.
- 3) Those awarded the service Medals in a particular year, shall not be eligible for the award of Silver Medal for that year.
- 4) Any individual who has displayed outstanding act of highest order which merits the award, is also eligible for the said award.

- 5) Participants of C.T.Operations of very high order are also eligible for the said award.

**CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF
D.G.'s GOLD MEDAL**

- 1) The individual should be recipient of DG's Commendation Medal or D.G.'s Silver Medal and a period of 05 years must have elapsed since the award of said medals.
- 2) The individual should have completed 15 years of unblemished service with 07 Outstanding grading/very good grading in the ACR/APR/Annual Remarks, for the last 10 years.
- 3) Those awarded the Service Medals in a particular year, shall not be eligible for the award of Silver Medal for that year.
- 4) Any individual who has displayed very high qualities of leadership during crises management and is a man of proven integrity and character is also eligible for the said award.
- 5) Participants of C.T.Operations of very high order are also eligible for the said award.

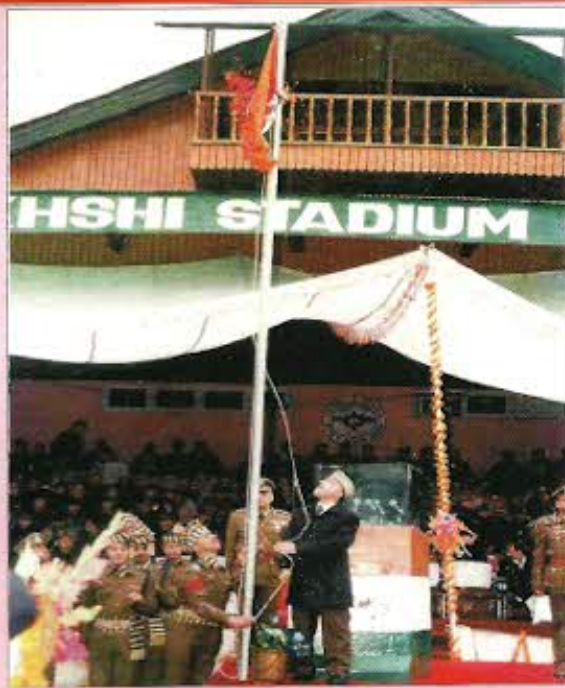
**CRITERIA FOR AWARD OF DGP's
COMMENDATION MEDAL
PARTIALLY MODIFIED**

The Criteria for award of Director General's Commendation Medal for the J&K Police personnel instituted vide PHQ orders No.934 of 1990 dated 01-09-1990 followed by subsequent modification vide PHQ orders No.4252 of 2004 dated 27-12-2004 has further been partially modified vide a recently issued PHQ order No.3852 of 2008 dated 30-12-2008.

The updated parameters for award of DGP's Commendation Medal after the issuance of PHQ order No.3852 of 2008 dated 30-12-2008 are:-

- 1) Outstanding good work requiring courage, skill, initiative
- 2) Outstanding good work during natural calamities.
- 3) Interesting innovations which result in improved working of the force,

- 4) Processing of difficult cases.
- 5) Criteria of total Police service rendered is 05 years.
- 6) Accident free driving and good record for a continuous period of 20 years.
- 7) Being graded outstanding in training courses of more than 2 weeks duration.
- 8) Any other outstanding or conspicuous work which may be of commendable nature etc.
- 9) The total number of DG's Commendation Medal to be awarded yearly is 200 out of which 50 medals are for Security Forces, SPOs/VDC members and citizens of J&K who have made outstanding contribution in maintenance of law and order.
- 10) Civilians, other than government servants, to be awarded DGP's Commendation Medal, shall also be given a lump-sum cash reward of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand)
- 11) 150 medals to be awarded to G.Os, NGOs and lower subordinate of various wings of J&K Police every year. Among the various wings of J&K Police the distribution is as.... 25 medals each to Kashmir & Jammu Zone, 30 medals to Armed Zone, 10 medals to CID, 10 medals to Modernization (Telecom/PTWs-2/Hospitals-2), 08 medals to Security, 08 medals to SKPA /Training Centres, 08 medals to PHQ, 06 medals to Crime & Railways, 05 medals to Traffic, 03 medals to SSG, 03 medals to Home guards/CD, 03 medals to Vigilance and 06 medals are DGP reserve.
- 12) The subordinate formations shall submit the recommendations for award of DGP's GOLD/SILVER and DGP's Commendation Medals to the Police Headquarters by November 15 of each year.
- 13) The list of awardees of DG's Silver and Gold Medal shall be announced on December 31, of each year.
