MUSHTAQ MEMORIAL FOOTBALL TOURN-AMENT TO BE HELD AT NATIONAL LEVEL FROM NEXT YEAR: DGP

The 4th Mushtaq Memorial Foot Ball Tournament, organised by J&K Police, concluded on June 15. The tournament being held annually in memory of late Mushtaq Ahmed Baba, the then SHO P/S Kothibagh, who sacrified his life while saving the lives of innocent civilians in Srinagar City on October, 31, 1997, was inaugurated by Sh. A.K Suri DGP, J&K, at Bakshi Stadium, Srinagar, on May 26.

37 teams participated in the tournament, which was spread over a period of 20 days (May, 26 -June, 15).

The final match was played between J&K Bank XI and BSF XI (J&K Frontier) at Bakshi Stadium Srinagar, on June, 15. J&K Bank XI emerged winners, beating BSF XI by 6 goals to 5. The match was decided by penalty shoot-outs because no goal was scored in the 90 minute stipulated time.

Thousands of sports loving people had thronged the stadium to witness the final match and the distinguished gathering included members of the state legislature, senior police, civil,

and paramilitary officers. Shri Gh. Mohi-ud-din Shah, acting Chief Minister, was the Chief guest at the concluding function.

Speaking at the function, the acting Chief Minister, Shri Gh. Mohi-ud-din Shah, appreciated the role of J&K police in combating militancy and restoring peace and normalcy in the state. Paying rich tributes to late Mushtaq Ahmed Baba, the acting Chief Minister said," Martyrs never die but prove to be torch bearers for the coming generations". He reiterated the need of looking after the families of police martyrs in a better and planned manner.

The Chief guest gave away the trophies and prizes/ mementoes to the teams and members of the organising committee.

On this occasion, J&K police, in association with J&K Football Association, also organised a lucky draw of the coupons, which had been issued to sports lovers, who had turned up to witness the match. Cash prizes of rupees 500 each were given to 07 coupon holders, by the chief guest.

J&K POLICE LADIES WELFARE ASSOCIA-TION'S CONCERN OVER WELFARE OF POLICE PERSONNEL

A Free medical camp, for the benefit of police personnel and their families, was organised by J&K Police ladies welfare association together with police Hospital, Srinagar.

Nearly 600 patients were examined by specialist doctors in surgery, medicines, ENT, Ophthalmology, paediatrics, orthopaedics, gynaecology and dermatology, at the camp, and provided treatment. ECG and USG facilities were also available at the camp.
