The genuine pride reflected in the special commendation, from His Excellency, the President of India, was extremely inspiring and touching. It was an affirmation of faith and trust which will serve the J&K Police to sustain in its continuing journey of restoring complete normalcy and peace in the state and achieving further professional excellence.

Immensely gratifying for J&K Police were the words of appreciation of its role by His Excellency, the President of India: "...It gives me great pleasure to present the 'colour' for the Jammu and Kashmir Police... I have brought great admiration for you because you are the Force- the first Force, who are dealing with all types of terrorism...You have made great sacrifices...860 people, who have given the life for the country's safety and security...

I understand that Jammu and Kashmir Police has grown from a strength of one officer and 14 *thanedars* in 1873 to the present strength of 60,000 members...From the conventional role of taking care of law and order situation, in the early stages, you have graduated to the status of a 'Force'...The year 1990 saw an upheaval in Kashmir, when the very edifice of National authority in the state was challenged. J&K Police was the only visible face of the state which was called upon to deliver multifarious functions- from municipality to food and supplies and armed duties etc... You have been associated with all joint operations with Army and Paramilitary Forces in the state. You have, indeed, contributed in a responsible way with courage and valour. J&K Police has been in a unique situation in Hazratbal and Charar-e-Sharief shrines periodically; every operation that you have carried out in such situations has distinct operational performance with efficiency..."

- Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam stressed on the need for:
- ▶ Inducting additional technologies like hi-tech computers, micro processors, field surveillance radars and important modules into J&K Police and other security forces for better efficiency;
  - ▶ Better coordination between Police of different states and security Forces; and
  - ▶ Periodical training of Police Force.

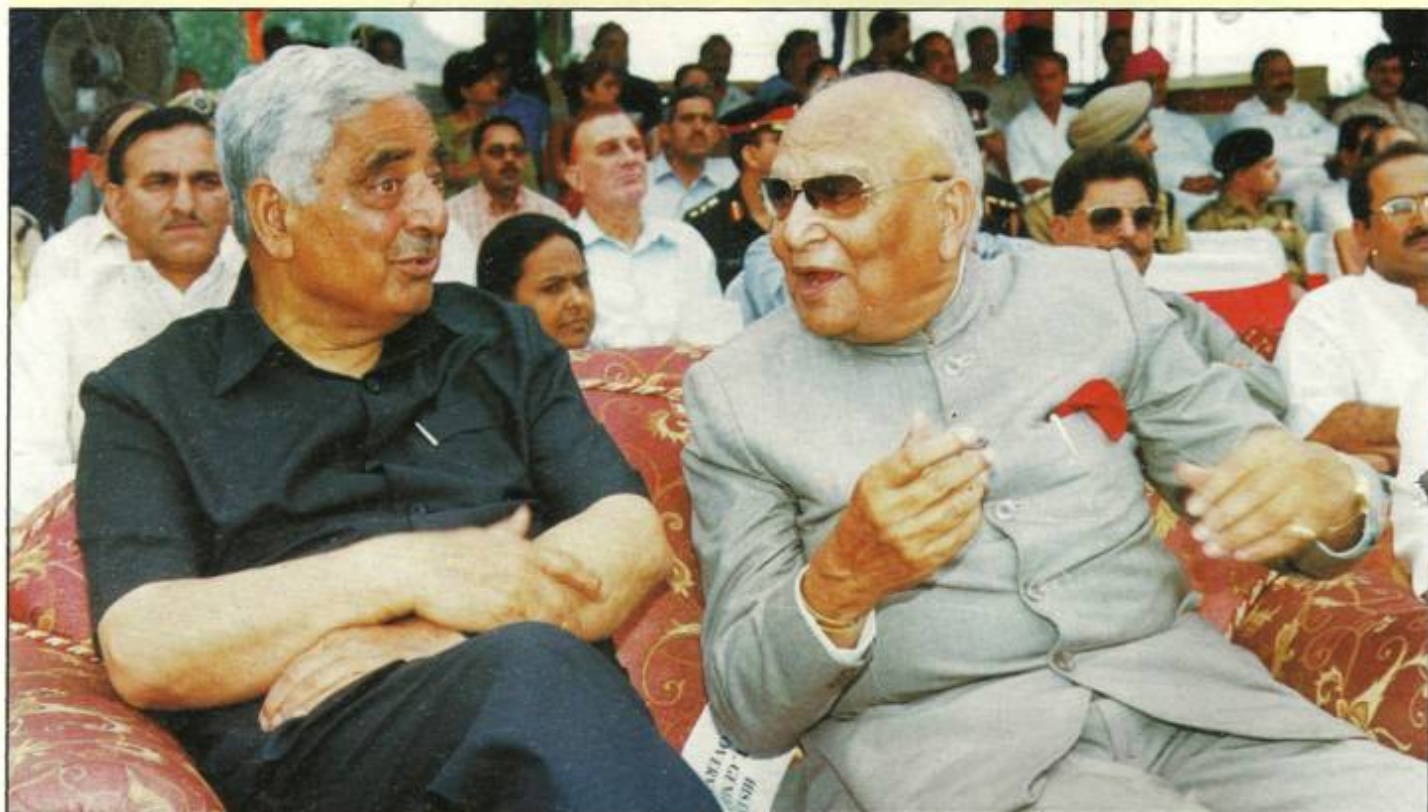

# Glory of colour

It is made of finest indigenous velvet, navy blue in colour, with golden fringes. It carries the national flag as also the J&K state flag on its left and the emblem of the J&K Police, in golden colour, on the right. Embroidered chinar tree leaves, in green, are just below the Police emblem. The vertical stripes represent the three geographic regions of J&K. The field of colours and their ingredients symbolise the spirit, discipline, loyalty, sacrifice, unity and bravery of J&K Police.

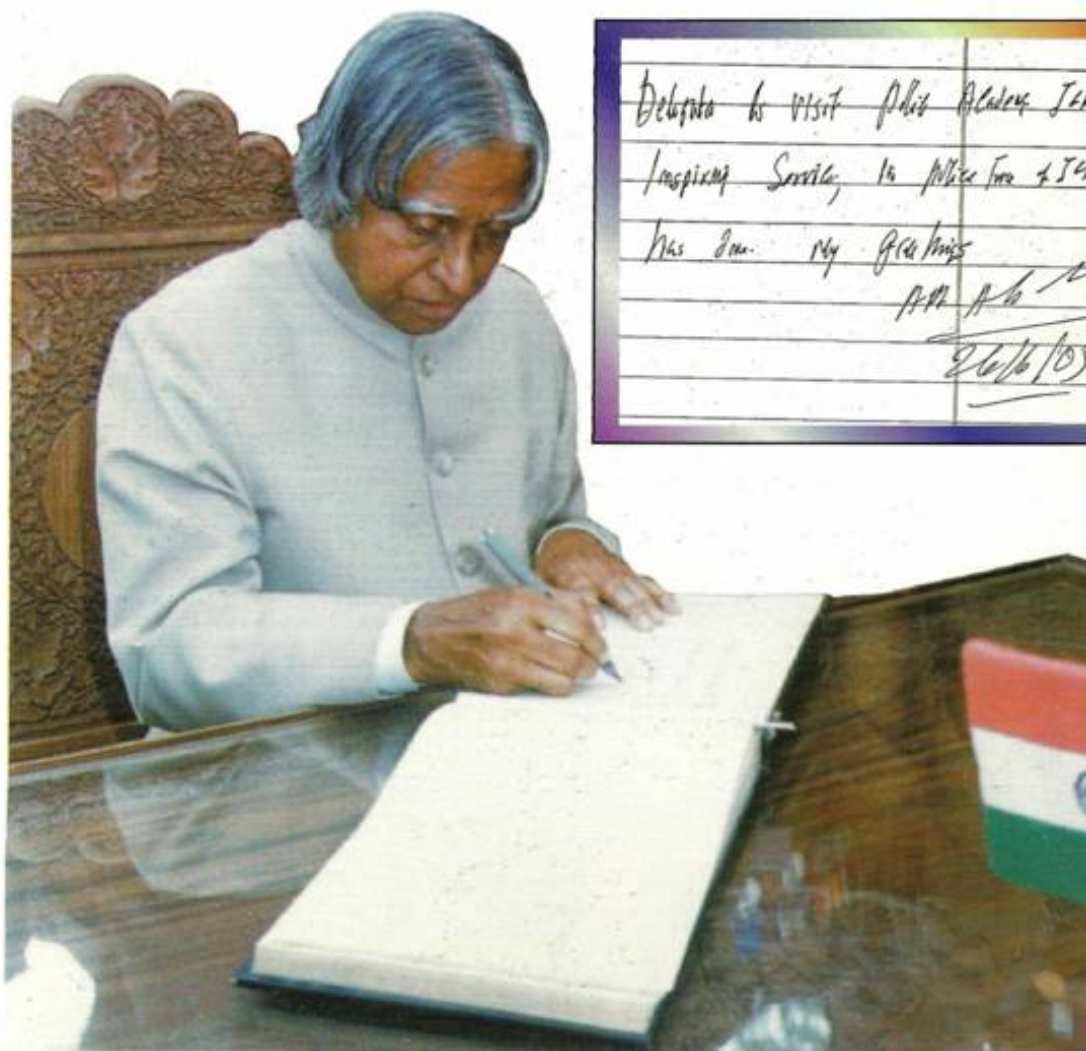

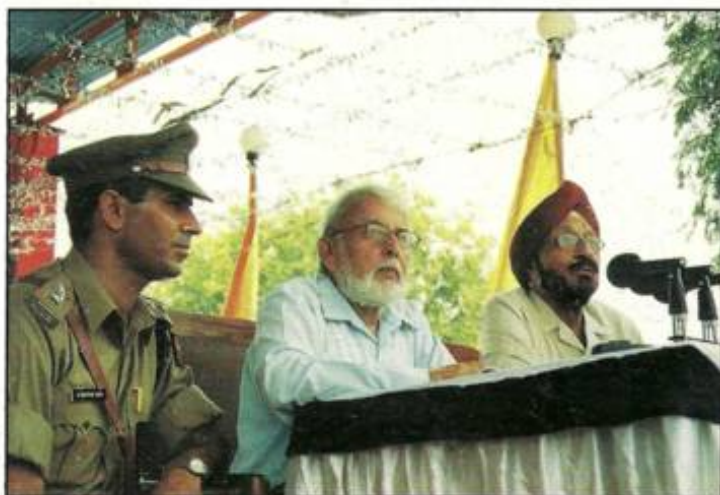

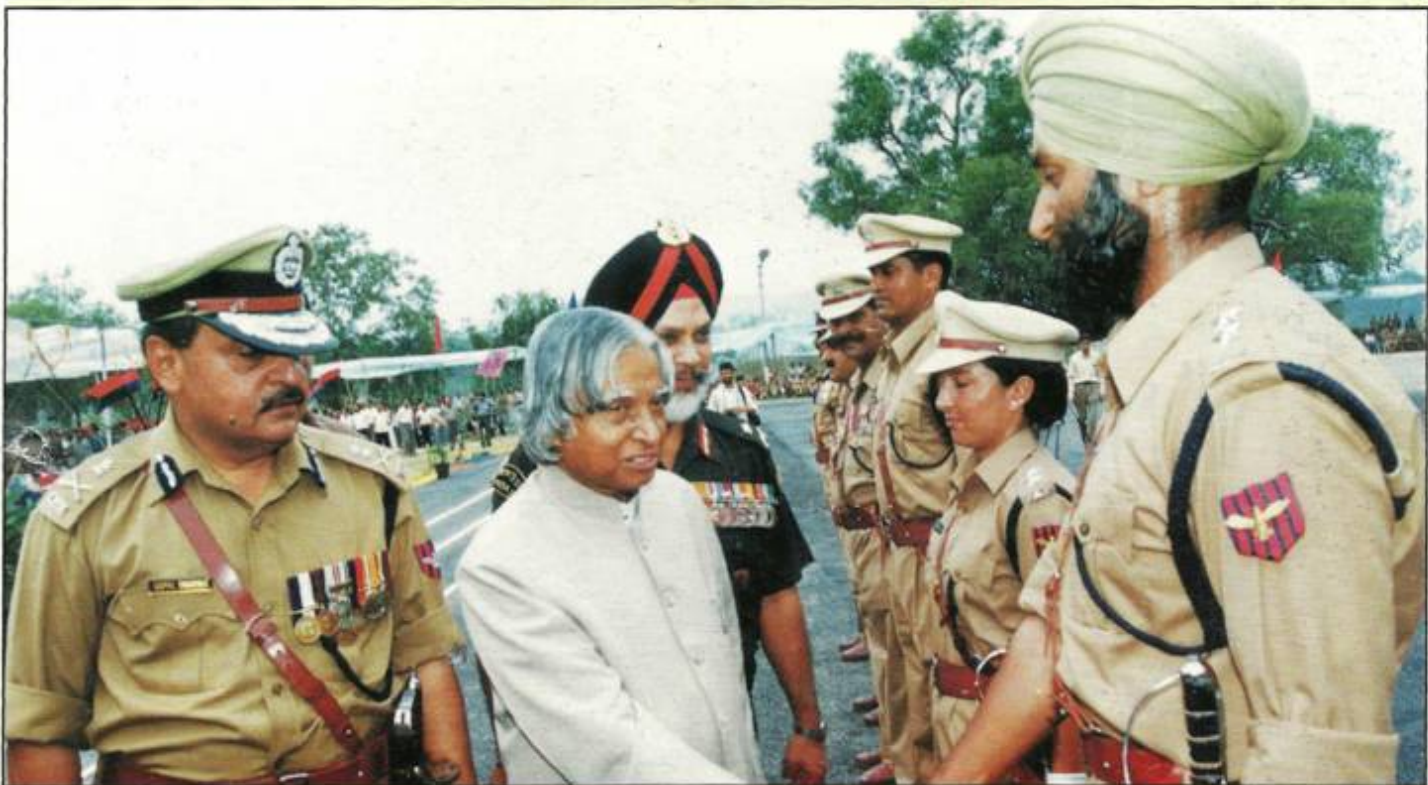

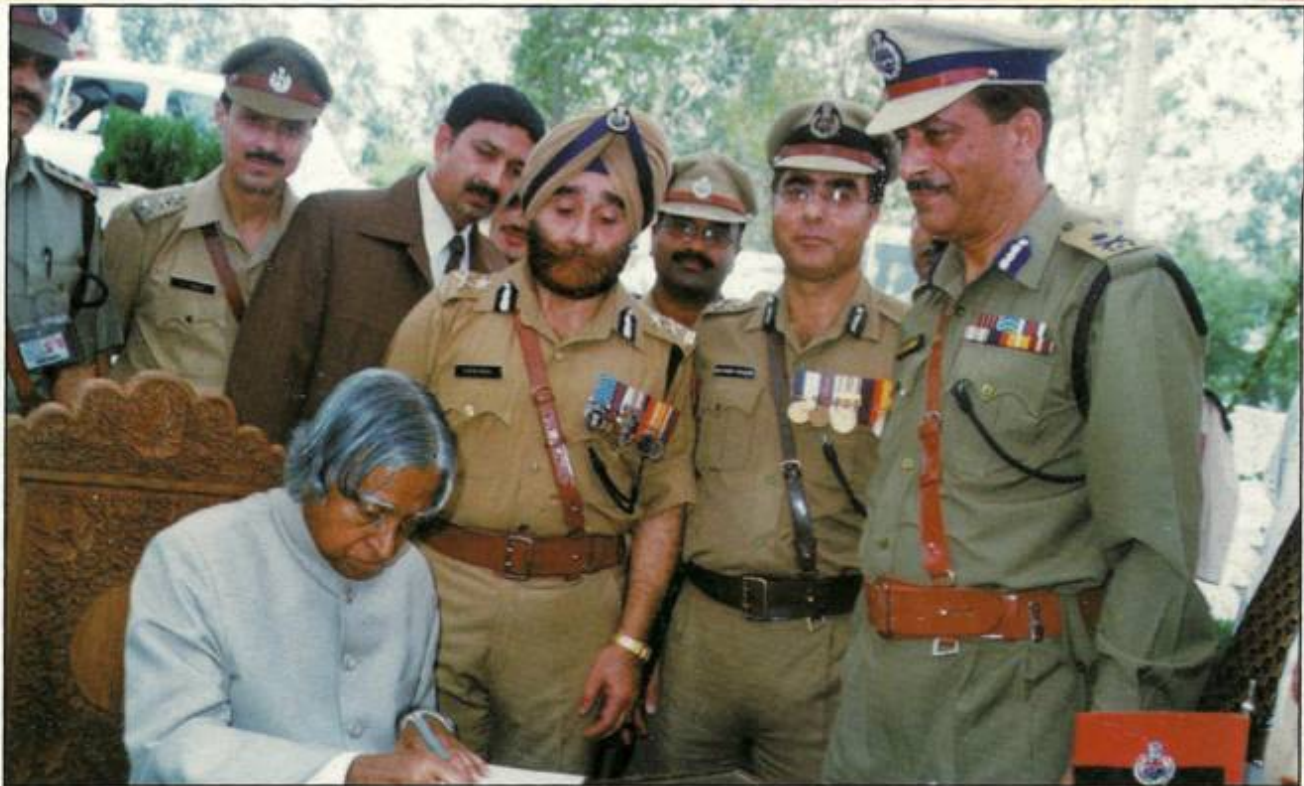

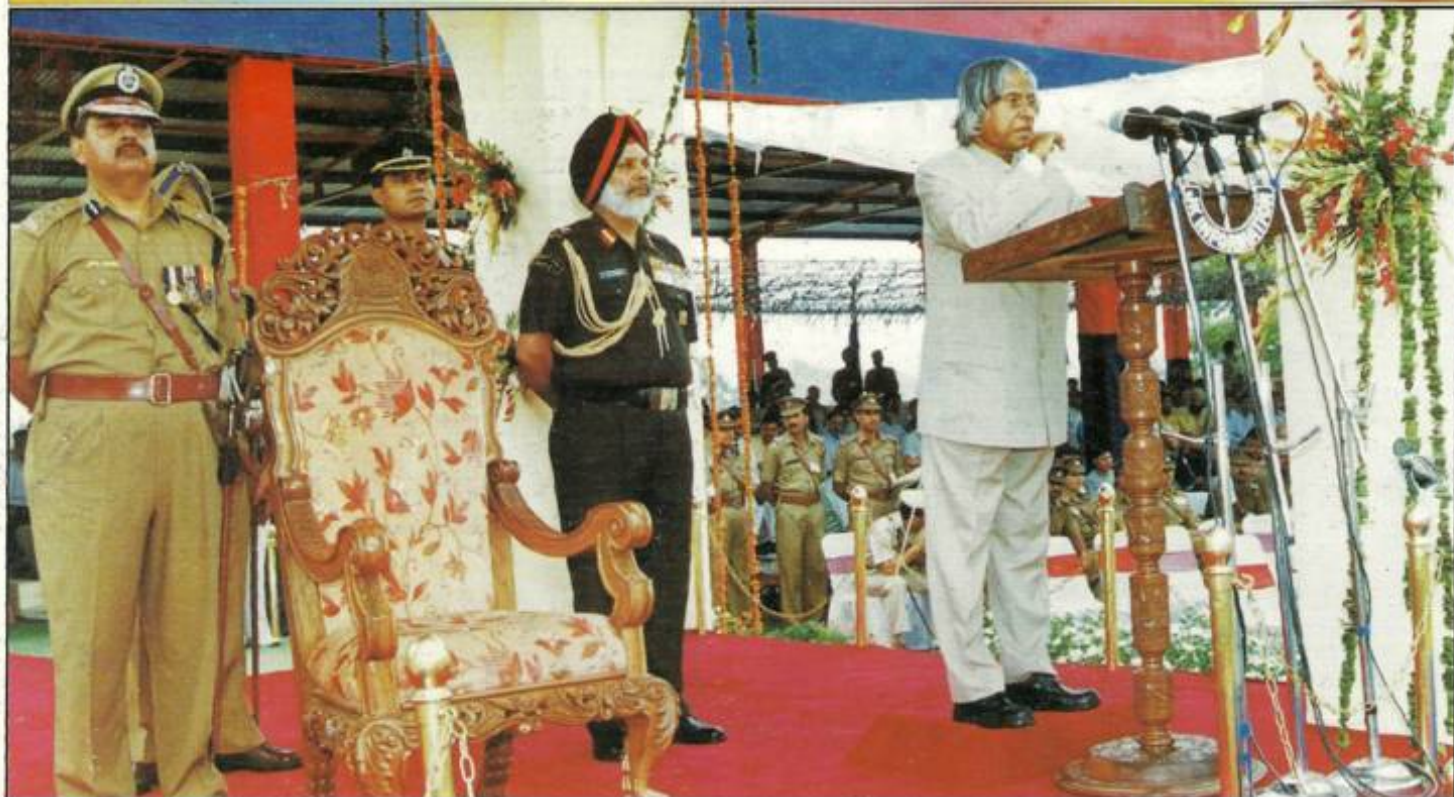
