4TH ANNUAL CIVIL DEFENCE WARDENS CONFERENCE ORGANIZED

Civil Defence was formalized under Civil Defence Act, 1968 which extends to whole of India. Civil Defence is to be organized as an integral part of the Defence of the Country. Its objectives are to save life, to minimize damage, to maintain continuity of production, and to keep up the high morale of public.

The 4th Civil Defence Conference was inaugurated by Shri Kuldeep Khoda IPS DGP J&K on July 6, 2009. During the inaugural address the DGP said that the role of Civil Defence is changing as the potential of conventional wars escalating into full-scale conflicts has diminished but new challenges are emerging in the form of threat from disasters both man-made and natural.

The state of J&K is vulnerable to earthquakes, being located in the seismic zone-V. Due to global warming J&K faces imminent threat from flash floods, cloud bursts etc.

During his welcome address Shri Dilbag Singh IPS IGP Home Guards Civil Defence and Auxiliary Police J&K stated that first conference was held at Jammu in the year 2005 followed by two more conferences in the year 2006 and 2007. In J&K State 19 towns are covered under the scheme, of which 10 are in Jammu and 09 in Kashmir including Leh and Kargil. The aims and objectives of holding such conference is to deliberate and discuss strategies to be adopted while dealing different kinds of disasters so as to

improve our response and ensure minimization of human and property losses.

The valedictory session was presided over by Dr. Ashok Bhan IPS who made valuable remarks and stressed for strengthening the Civil Defence set up.

DGP J&K HELD DURBAR FOR FAMILIES OF POLICE MARTYRS AND SERVING POLICE PERSONNEL

In a function organized by Armed Police at Police Welfare Centre in Police Housing Colony Bemina, Srinagar on June 30, 2009. Shri Kuldeep Khoda IPS DGP J&K held a durbar of families of Police Martyrs & serving Police personnel.

During his address, the DGP assured the families of police martyrs and serving personnel that whole police establishment is always with them to redress their grievances as police personnel working in the organization invariably remain away from their homes attending to call of the duties and they are unable to attend properly to the issues and problems at home. The DGP said that welfare of police personnel and their families is always his priority and efforts

would be made to mitigate their problems.

The DGP said that besides other welfare measures, priority has been given to the education of wards of police personnel and in this regard the educational standard of the police public schools across the state has been improved and latest facilities have been provided in these schools. He stressed upon the police families to appreciate the importance of imparting quality education to their children.

During the interaction with families of martyrs and other police personnel, the DGP listened to their problems patiently and discussed these with authorities present on the occasion and gave on the spot

instructions to solve the problems on priority.

On the occasion, Shri Kuldeep Khoda IPS DGP J&K handed over one wheel chair to Head Constable Abdul Hamid who became incapacitated while performing his duties. He also sanctioned financial assistance of Rs. 20,000/- to a widow of police personnel.
