JAMMU & KASHMIR POLICE ORGANIZED CYCLE RACE AT SRINAGAR

The Jammu and Kashmir Police organized a cycle race on July 23, 2011 at Srinagar under its civic action programme. The race was flagged off by Shri Kuldeep Khoda IPS DGP J&K from Police Golf Course, Boulevard Road in which a large number of cyclists representing different age groups took part. The DGP was accompanied by a large number of senior police officers during the flag-off ceremony. The participants were divided in three categories to represent open, junior and sub-junior groups. J&K Cyclists Association Vice President Shri Mushtaq Ahmad, General Secretary Shri Mukhtar Rasool and senior citizen Shri Ghulam Rasool of 80 years of age also took part in the race. The open category participants of the race were required to return the venue after reaching the destination

Hazratbal via Foreshore road whereas the participants of junior category were required to reach venue from the destination Duck Park. Similarly the sub-juniors (Boys and girls) contingents were required to return to the venue from the destination Royal Springs.

On the culmination of the race, prize distribution function was held in which winners of all categories were awarded with cash prizes. The participants of the cycle race who secured 1st eight positions in open category were awarded cash prize amounting to Rs. 7500/-, Rs. 6500/-, Rs. 6000/-, Rs. 5000/-, Rs. 4000/-, Rs. 3500/-, Rs. 3000/- and Rs. 2500/- respectively.

The participants who secured 1st eight positions in junior category under 18 age group were awarded cash reward amounting to Rs. 6000/-, Rs. 5000/-, Rs. 4000/-, Rs. 3000/-, Rs. 2500/-, Rs. 2000/-, Rs. 1500/- and Rs. 1000/- respectively.

The participants securing first, second, third positions in the sub-junior (Boys category) were awarded cash prize amounting to Rs. 2500/-, Rs. 2000/- and Rs. 1500/- respectively whereas its 4th to 10th position holders were awarded cash prize amounting to Rs. 1000/- each. In Sub-junior (Girls category) cash prize amounting to Rs. 2500/- Rs. 2000/- and Rs. 3000/- were awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd position holders respectively whereas its 4th to 10th position holders were awarded Rs. 1000/- each. 04 participants being youngers in sub-junior category of the cycle race were awarded consolation prizes amounting to Rs. 500/- each.

DGP J&K who was the chief guest on the valedictory function congratulated the winners of the race. While addressing the function, the DGP said that Jammu and Kashmir Police has framed a calendar of sports

events and tournaments throughout the year with an aim to inspire the youth of the State towards the sports for their physical and mental nourishment.
