BLOOD DONATION CAMP ORGANISED

A blood donation camp was organised in Police Hospital, Srinagar, on June 19 for injured SF/PMF personnel in Kargil as well as elsewhere in the state, Police personnel injured in anti-militancy operations and innocent civilians targeted by militants. The camp was inaugurated by Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, in which over 100 Police personnel of various wings of the department donated blood.

DGP ANNOUNCES STEPS TO SENSITISE POLICE PERSONNEL ON ISSUES RELATED TO HUMAN RIGHTS

The Director General of Police, J&K, Shri Gurbachan Jagat while formulating an Action Plan for safeguarding Human Rights of the citizens, has stressed on the need to focus on Human Rights education. The steps to sensitise Police Personnel on issues related to Human Rights include :

- ☆ Superintendents of Police and Commandants to address and

educate the men working under them periodically on issues relating to Human Rights.

- ☆ Officers of the rank of Dy. Inspector General of Police and above to address Police personnel during *darbars*, meetings and inspections.

- ☆ Holding of workshops and seminars at Police Academy Udhampur so as to develop strategies to prevent/deal with Human Rights violations.

- ☆ To include Human Rights education in the training syllabus of Police Personnel.

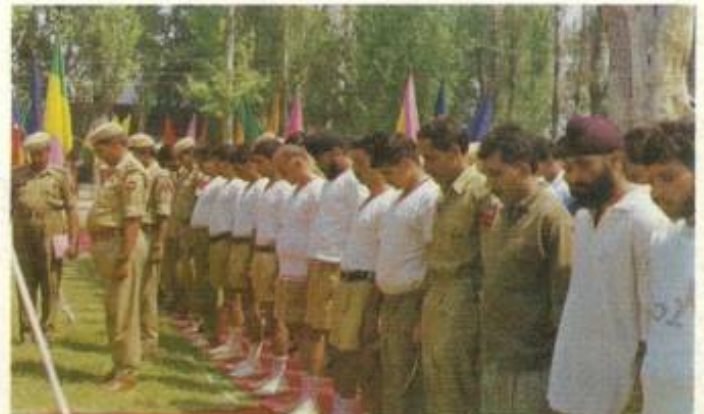
- ☆ Providing a manual of Do's and Don'ts to Police Personnel for the protection of Human Rights.

- ☆ Senior Police officers visiting Police Training Academy and other training institutes in the state to address the trainees on issues relating to Human Rights, gender sensitisation and Juvenile delinquency etc.

- ☆ Publishing of special issue of J&K Police News Letter which shall focus on various aspects of Human Rights.

- ☆ Constituting a complaint cell at Police Headquarters to monitor complaints regarding Human rights violation.

- ☆ Efforts to be made in networking with various Government and NGOs working in the field of Human Rights.

RAISING DAY OF IR 1st AND IIInd Bns.

A colourful programme organised by IR 1st and IIInd battalion marked the celebration of their 5th raising day at Armed Police Complex Zewan on June 22. Dr Ahok Bhan, Inspector General of Police, Armed, J&K was the Chief Guest who took salute at an impressive parade. He praised the officers and men of their performance particularly their role in anti-militancy operations. RECRUITMENT OF IR V AND VI BATTALIONS.

A recruitment board headed by Shri R.V.Raju IGP Crime and Railways, J&K, has nearly completed the process of recruiting 2000 constables against the posts of IR V and VI Battalions. The board has been visiting every District Headquarters and making announcement of selection list immediately after completion of the recruitment process. Simultaneously, verification rolls are being referred by Armed Police to the concerned agencies and verifications in respect of candidates from Districts Poonch and

Kathua have already been received. Headquarters of IR V and VI Battalions have been created in Gulshan Ground, Jammu and Armed Police Complex, Zewan respectively. Shri Karnail Singh and Shri Raiful Hassan are the Commandants of these newly raised Battalions. The training of personnel of these Battalions will be carried out at Talwara (Reasi) and Sheeri (Baramulla) from August 16.

DESIGNS OF PAKISTAN FOILED BY LEH POLICE

Acting on a tip-off, Leh Police meticulously planned an operation and arrested 22 militants and recovered a big cache of weapons and ammunition from Nubra valley. The seized weapons include 25 AK-47 Rifles, 3 Machine Guns, 7 Kgs of RDX and about 3000 Rounds of ammunition. The seized weapons, recovered at the instance of arrested militants had been smuggled in from across the LAC and dumped in the high altitudes.

The arrested militants had been lured and roped in to spread militancy in a hither-to militancy free Ladakh area and with the timely action of Leh Police the attempt of ISI was scuttled. The achievement has been applauded by His Excellency the Governor Shri G.C.Saxena, Chief Minister Dr. Farooq Abdullah and Director General of Police Shri Gurbachan Jagat. Police personnel associated with the operations have been rewarded.

Operations Commander of Hizbul Mujahideen and Shahid Salim Sheikh @ Fayaz Ahmed resident of Bidipora, Lolab, self styled battalion commander of Hizbul Mujahideen were killed by a team of SOG in an encounter in Lalpora area of Kupwara district on June 05. 2 AK Rifles, 3 Hand Grenades, 1 Wireless Set and ammunition were recovered from slain militants.

Mohd Sharief @ Abdul, a native of Karnool district of Andhra Pradesh, an ISI saboteur, was apprehended by Bishnah Police (District Jammu) near village Pandori on June 3. His interrogation led to the recovery of 2 Chinese Pistols, 4 Magazines, 20 Cartridges, 1 Hand Grenade and 17 Electric Detonators. During interrogation he revealed some vital clues about the game plan of ISI.

CODE OF CONDUCT OF POLICE

★ The Police must bear faithful allegiance to the constitution of India and J&K and respect and uphold the rights of the citizens as guaranteed by it.

★ The police should not question the propriety or necessity of any law duly enacted. They should enforce the law firmly and impartially, without fear or favour, malice or vindictiveness.

★ The police should recognize and respect the limitations of their powers and functions. They should not usurp or even seem to usurp the functions of the Judiciary and sit on judgement on cases to avenge individuals and punish the guilty.

★ In securing the observance of the law or in maintaining order, the police should, as far as practicable, use the methods of persuasion, advice and warning. When the application of force becomes inevitable, only the irreducible minimum of force required in the circumstances should be used.

★ The prime duty of the police is to prevent crime and disorder and the police must recognize that the test of their efficiency is the absence of both and not the visible evidence of police action in dealing with them.

★ The police must recognize that they are members of the public, with the only difference that in the interest of the society and on its behalf they are employed to give full time attention to duties which are normally incumbent on every citizen to perform.

★ The police should realize that the efficient performance of their duties will be dependent on the extent of ready cooperation that they receive from the public. This in turn, will depend on the ability to secure public approval of their conduct and actions and to earn and retain public respect and confidence.

★ The police should always keep the welfare of the people in mind and be sympathetic considerate towards them. They should always be ready to offer individual service and friendship and render necessary assistance to all without regard to their wealth or social standing.

★ The police should always place duty before self, should remain calm in the face of danger, scorn or ridicule and should be ready to sacrifice their lives in protecting those of others.

★ The police should always be courteous and well mannered, they should be dependable and impartial; they should possess dignity and courage; and should cultivate character and the trust of the people.

★ Integrity of the highest order is the fundamental basis of the prestige of the police. Recognizing this, the police must keep their private lives scrupulously clean, develop self restraint and be truthful and honest in thought and deed in both personal and official life, so that the public may regard them as exemplary citizens.

★ The police should recognize that their full utilities to the state is best ensured only by maintaining a high standard of discipline, faithful performance of duties in accordance with law and implicit obedience to the lawful directions of commanding ranks and absolute loyalty to the force and by keeping themselves in a state of constant training and preparedness.

★ As members of a secular, democratic state the police should strive continually to rise above personal prejudices and promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities and to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women and disadvantaged segments of the society.
