### INTRODUCING MODERN TECHNOLOGY AND COMPUTERIZATION- ESSENTIAL FOR EFFECTIVE POLICING : C.M. J&K.

In his address, at the Passing out Parade (POP) of the 3rd batch of recruit constables at Subsidiary Police Training Centre (STC), Talwara (Reasi), on May, 30, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, J&K, Stressed on the essence of imparting training to *Jawans* in "the art of combating" and also the need to introduce modern technology and computerization in J&K Police for improving its efficiency and raising the professional status of Police work.

The Chief Minister congratulated the recruits, on the completion of their basic training, and also the trainers, who had put in their best efforts in training them. You choose to join police service; recognised the importance of Police Profession, of which you became the members; accepted the responsibility; and, now after having been provided the basic training, you shall have to carry-out your duties in a manner most conducive to the public good", Chief Minister impressed on the recruits.

"You have to ensure public order for which you yourself have to work in an ordered and disciplined manner", C.M. added.

Earlier, the Chief Minister inspected the parade and took salute at an impressive march-past. among others, Sh. A.K. Suri, DGP, J&K, Sh. Gopal Sharma, ADGP (Armed), Sh. P.R. Gandotra, DIG, Armed, Jammu, Sh. Mohamad Sayeed Khan, District Magistrate, Udhampur, Sh. A. R. Shan, Principal, STC, Talwara, senior Army, B.S.F. officers and prominent citizens of Reasi were present at the function.

## MILITANCY IN J&K IS THE BRAINCHILD OF ISI: GOPAL SHARMA, ADGP (ARMED) J&K

In his speech at the inaugural function of the three-day (May, 15 to 17) vertical interaction course on "Policing in militancy and terrorism", Sh. Gopal Sharma, ADGP(Armed) said that Pakistan is providing logistics and support to sustain militancy in J&K besides sending mercenaries. "The militancy in J&K is the brainchild of ISI, which has opened camps in different parts of Pakistan and POK to train the militants for perpetrating death and destruction in J&K, Sh. Sharma added. The valedictory address was delivered by Sh. M.M. Khajuria, former Director General of Police. He exhorted the participants to prepare themselves for meeting the challenges of terrorism.

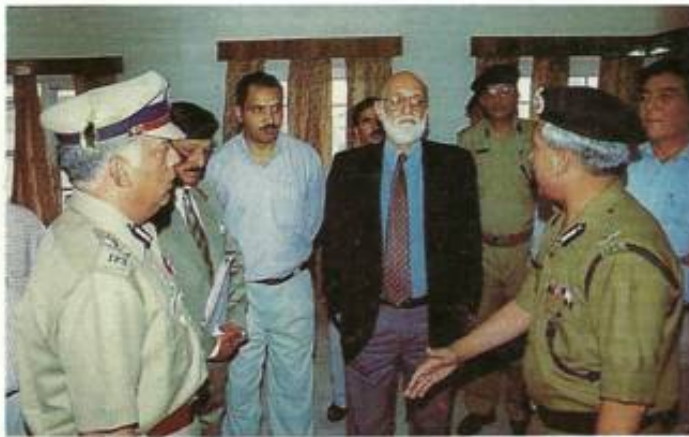

DGP distributed cash awards to the police personnel in recognition of their outstanding performance in antimilitancy operations. Besides, 10 police personnel were promoted out-of-turn and 15 SPO's appointed as Constables by the DGP on-the-spot, for their valorous role in fighting militants.

## MAJOR SUCCESS IN ANTI-MILITANCY

- 6 foreign mercenaries were killed in joint operation by SOG & Army at Nalli near Dhara Sangla (Surenkote) on May, 01.
- SOG eliminated two HUM militants identified as Rafiqud Din Khan and Naveen Jehadi, both natives from Blouchistan (Pak), at Srijipora (Kupwara) on May, 12.
- 2 foreign mercenaries, identified as Abu Muslim Zazar, Self styled Divisional Commander of LeT Rajouri and Poonch and Abu Akshir, Self styled area commander of LeT Surenkote, were eliminated in a joint operation launched by Army and Police in Surankote area, on May, 12.
- 3 foreign mercenaries were killed in fierce gun-battle between the SOG, backed up by Army and the militants at village Sungal Sama (Akhnoor) on May, 13.
- 5 militants, all hailing from Pakistan, were killed in an encounter with SOG & Army at Dhara Sangla (Surenkote) on May, 17.
- SOG Doda eliminated 7 foreign mercenaries, belonging to Jesh-e-Mohammad out fit, at Rikanwas Sukhani village in Warwan area of Doda District on May 22.

- In a joint operation by SOG, Army & BSF, two Pak mercenaries, belonging to j-e-m, were eliminated at village Batnoor (Tral) on May, 26.
- 7 militants belonging to LeT out-fit, were killed in three different operations, jointly conducted by SOG Poonch and Army in Surenkote area on May, 27.
- Taimoor Ahmed and Ghazi Abdul, both foreign mercenaries were eliminated in Khari forest (Banihal) on May, 25, in a joint operation by SOG and RR.
- A foreign mercenary, identified as Momhad Yousef @ Abu Khalid, was gunned down by SOG at Anantnag on May, 04.
- A joint search party of SOG and Army killed an LeT militant, identified as Abu Zubair, at Dangiwacha (Baramullah), on May, 24.
- Abu Hamza @ Asif @ Omar, a Pak mercenary district commander of J-e-M, was killed in an encounter at village Chewa (Sumbal) on May 30.
