POLICE HEADQUARTERS REOPENS IN SUMMER CAPITAL



Following its closure in the winter capital (Jammu), for the biannual move on April 28, the J&K Police Headquarters reopened in the summer capital (Srinagar) on May 09.

Newer challenges, confronting the police in the state, have necessiated imparting advance-training skills to the men of J&K Police. New subjects including 'policing the environment' and 'Techno Busting' have been added to the Syllabi of training at Sher-e-Kashmir Police Academy Udhampur.

A batch of 34 police officers were imparted training in identifying and tracking down the invisible enemy through a mobile phone call, during the month of May 2005.
