### STATE POLICE AND SECURITY FORCES HAVE DONE WELL IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS : CM

Dr Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, J&K, presiding over a meeting of the Unified Command on May 21 at Jammu, has lauded the successes achieved by the security forces and J&K Police in anti-militancy operations. The Chief Minister showed satisfaction over operations carried out in the difficult hilly terrains of Doda, Udhampur, Poonch and Rajouri Districts. The meeting was attended, among others, by the Chief Secretary, Shri Ashok Jaitly, Lt. General A.S. Khanna, GOC 16 Corps, Director General of Police, Shri

Gurbachan Jagat and Principal Secretary (Home) Shri Phunsog. The Chief Minister urged for maintaining extra vigil to frustrate and comprehensively defeat the nefarious designs of enemy and served a note of caution by adding that there was no room for complacency as Pakistan continued to direct trained mercenaries into the state to sustain militancy. The Chief Minister laid emphasis on the importance of close co-operation among various security and intelligence agencies and local administration to stamp out the residual militancy.

The inaugural function was presided over by Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, on May 17. The DGP,



in his inaugural address, stressed on the need for proper utilization of sophisticated equipment now available with J&K Police. He emphasised that with increase in the number of wireless sets, it has become imperative to maintain net discipline and avoid communication breaches. In his welcome address, Shri Navin Agarwal, Director Police Telecommunication, spelled out the need for organising the week long

### ANTI POLLUTION DRIVE LAUNCHED BY TRAFFIC POLICE IN JAMMU

Traffic wing of J&K Police launched a campaign against environmental pollution in Jammu and booked 481 drivers of vehicles which were emitting excessive smoke. During the month of May, a record number of 14216 drivers were booked for violation of various provisions of M.V. Act and Rules and an amount of Rs. 13,02,429 was realised as compound money. Of the erring drivers, 157 were booked for contravention of route permit, 2845 for overloading, 27 for overcharging, 244 for holding invalid driving licences, 283 for double pillion riding, 61 for using shrill horns, 7351 for not using safety helmets, 731 for driving without licence and 2189 for parking at wrong places.
