SHRI GOPAL SHARMA IPS - NEW POLICE CHIEF OF J&K

In an informal chat with the officers of J&K Police, at Police Headquarters, Srinagar, on May 20, soon after his taking over as Director General of J&K Police, Shri Gopal Sharma said, *"My effort will be to identify myself with you— I shall empathise with you to vibrate and communicate with ease so that there is free exchange of ideas and fruitful interaction. I shall work to create an environment where every member of the force can work to his fullest potential, by opening every possible avenue for personal contribution to keep the 'J&K Police flag' flying high.*

The occasion of taking over as DGP of J&K State by Shri Gopal Sharma IPS (RR-72-J&K cadre) was marked by the scenes of rejoicing in Police Headquarters. It was like a family gathering, albeit a very large family, looking forward to the future excellence of J&K Police under the able and masterful leadership of Shri Gopal Sharma.

After taking over as DGP, J&K, Shri Gopal Sharma held a meeting of zonal SsP, SDPOs and S.H.Os of Srinagar District and reviewed the law and order situation. IGP, Kashmir zone, DIG, Central Kashmir Range and SSP, Srinagar also attended the meeting.
