The DGP revealed that 17 Sub-Divisions, 50 Police Stations and 206 Police posts are being created and sanction of 4191 posts for new as well as existing old districts is being sought. A separate Medical Service for Jammu & Kashmir police is also being created for specialized medical treatment in cases of extreme emergency, DGP disclosed. Accompanied by S/Shri P.L. Gupta IGP Hqrs, Mohammed Subhan Lone DIG CKR, Syed Afad-ul- Mujtaba SSP Srinagar, SP Hazratbal and other senior police officers DGP also visited Hazratbal Shrine and reviewed the Security arrangements in connection with Eid-UI-Milad.

■ During the month of March Shri K Rajendra Kumar IPS after taking over as IGP Jammu Zone, conducted a series of surprise visits to various Police Stations of Jammu district including Channi Himmat, Trikuta Nagar, Gandhi Nagar, Satwari, Bari Brahma, Miran Sahib, Gangyal, Pacca Danga, Bakshi Nagar, Nowabad, City, Janipur, Domana, Kanachak and Akhnoor and passed on spot instructions to the SHOs and Incharge Police Posts concerned to ensure the beat system and alertness of police personnel at different naka points during night hours by conducting surprise checkings. The IGP stressed the officers for adopting friendly attitude towards general public and heeding their grievances under all circumstances.

■ Shri S. Owais IPS IGP Armed J&K visited district Poonch & Rajouri from March 14 to 16. During the month of March 2008, 14 hardcore militants including a self styled Divisional Commander of LeT and a District Commander of HM got killed in different encounters with J&K Police across the state and 02 militants surrendered before the Police.

The arms and ammunition recovered during the month include 30 AK 47/56 rifles, 105 AK magazines, 7773 AK rounds, 04 UBGL, 10 UBGL Grenades, 44 Hand Grenades, 22 Pistols, 10 Pistol Magazines, 62 Wireless sets, 1 LMG and 1 Sniper rifle. A Laptop of slain pakistani terrorist responsible for attack on Martyr Dy.SP Shalley Singh containing incriminating information was also recovered from a Doda based OGW of L-e-T Outfit during a raid launched by Doda police on March 17.
