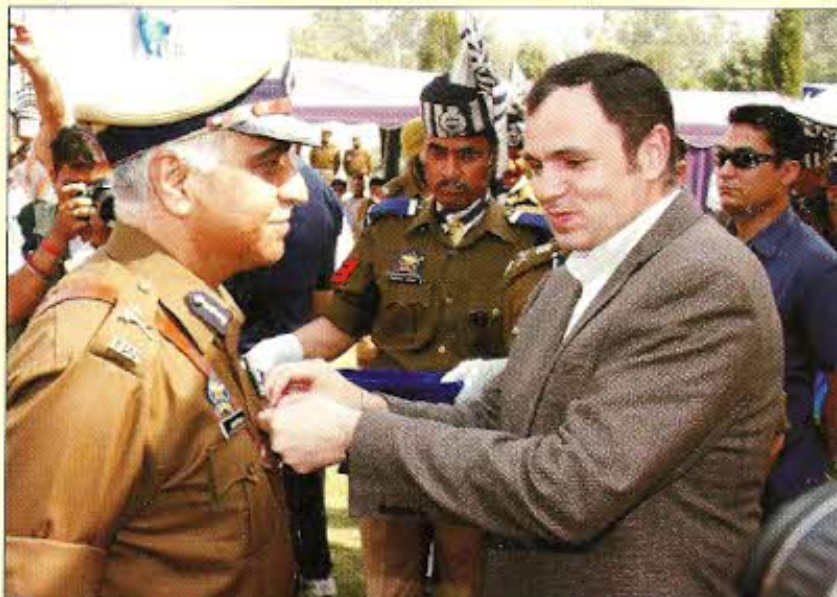

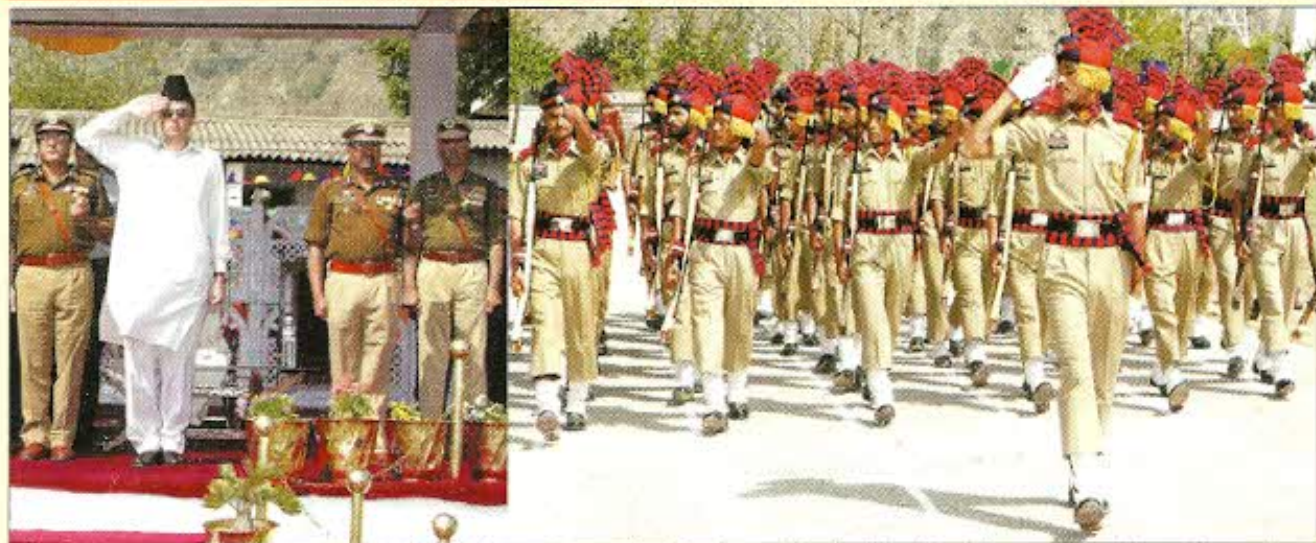

Hon'ble Chief Minister J&K Shri Omar Abdullah who was the Chief Guest on the occasion took the salute of the parade and addressed the passout trainees..

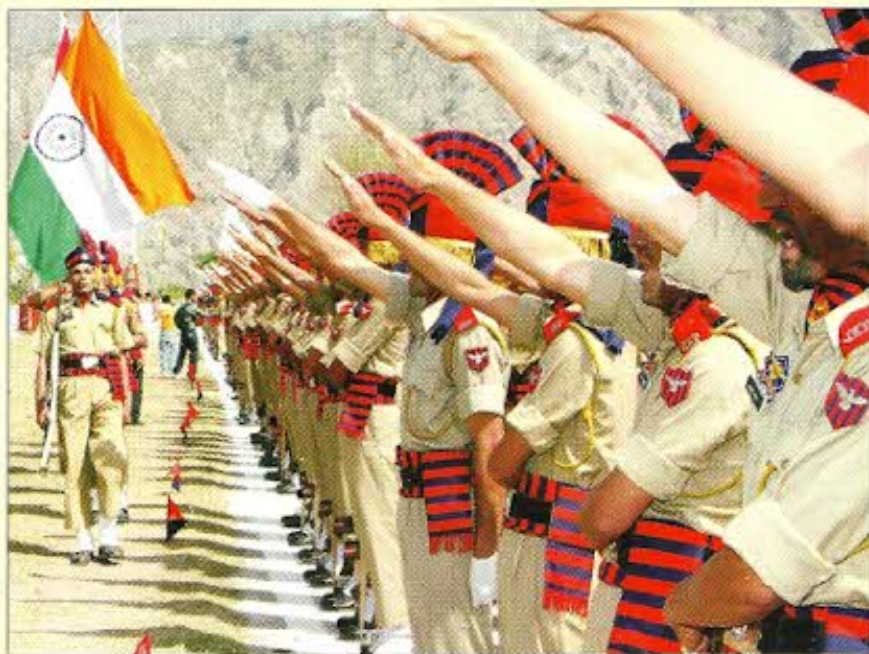

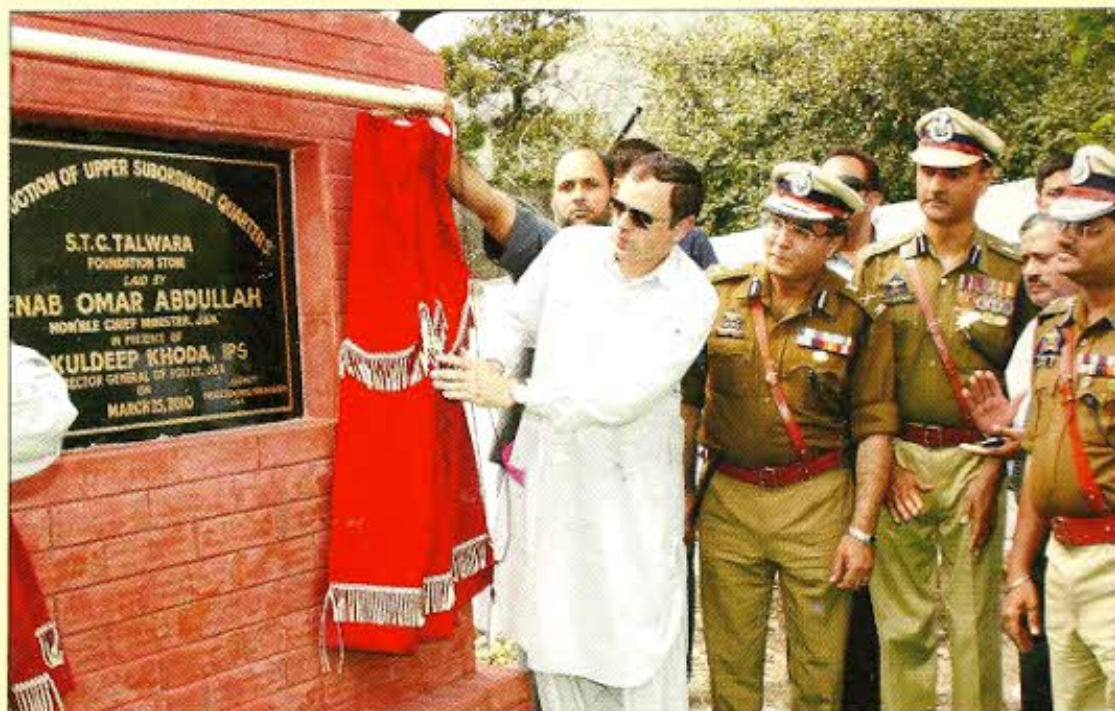

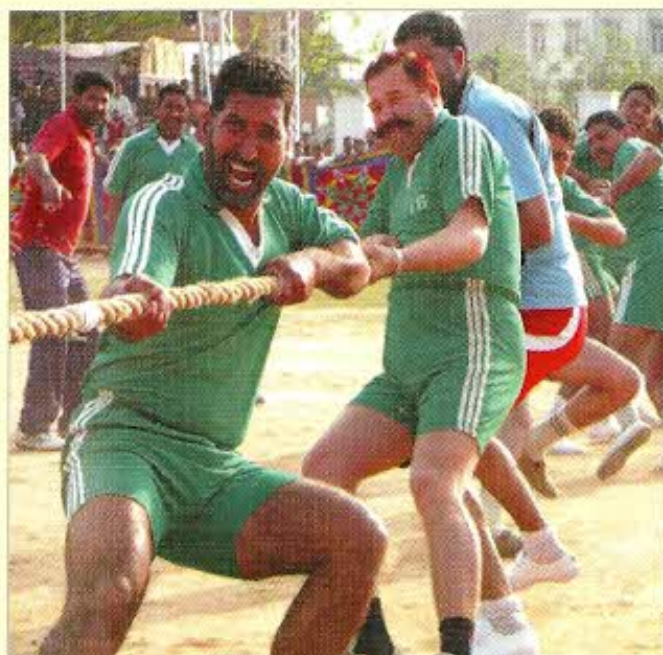

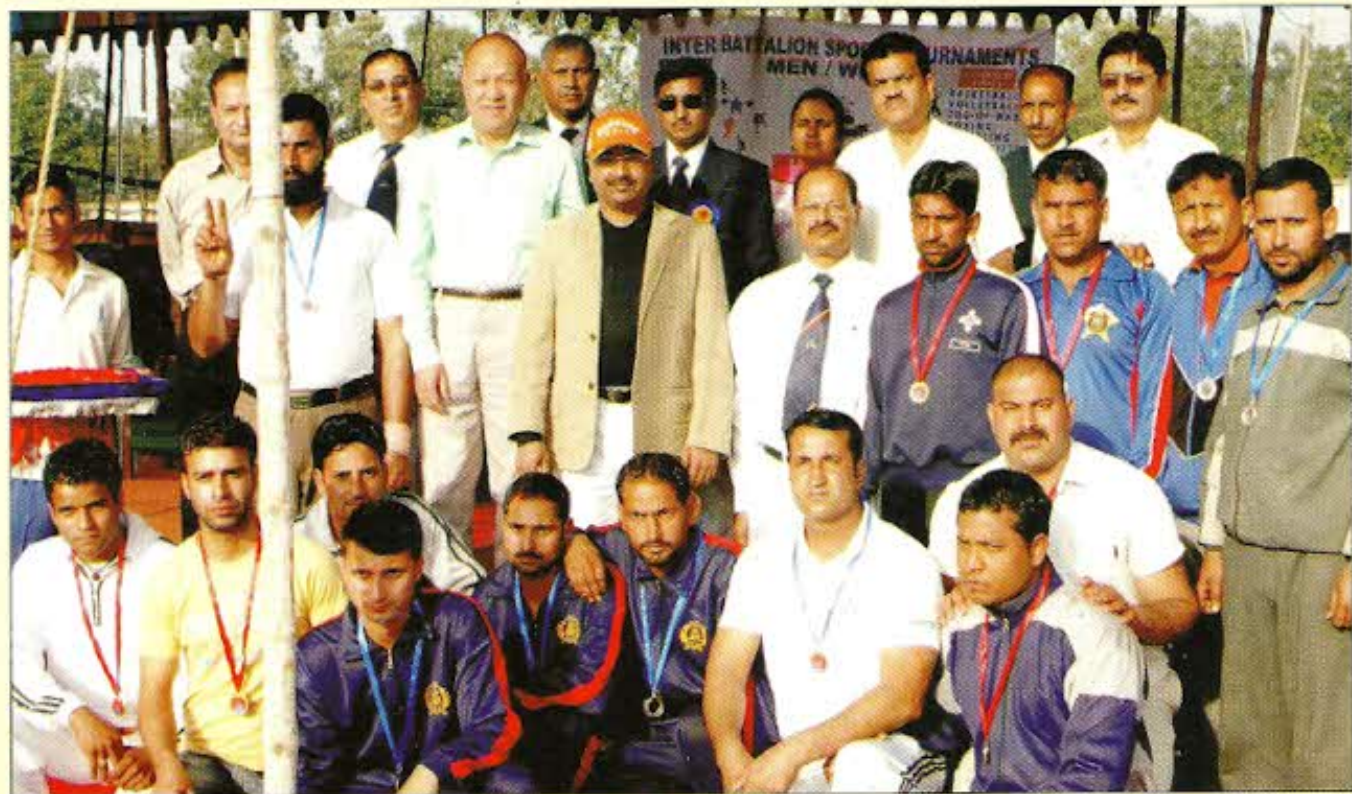

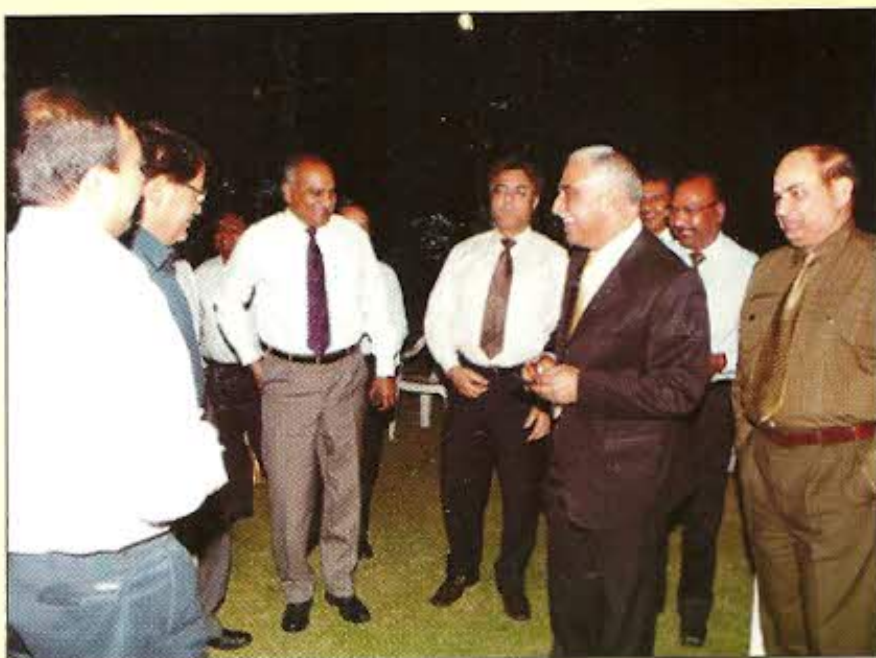
