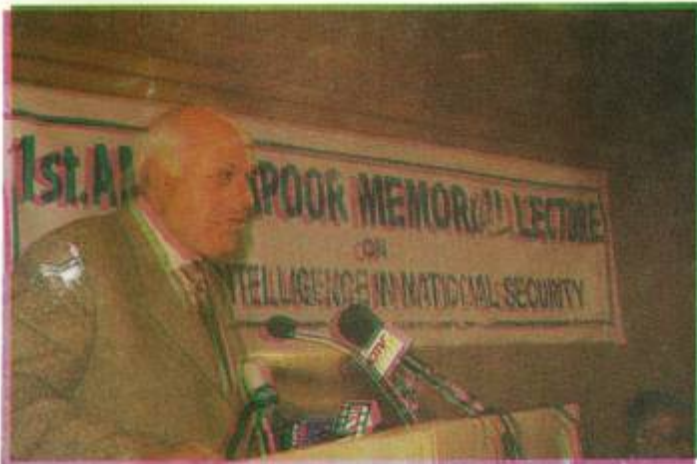

AMAR KAPOOR MEMORIAL LECTURE

Shri M.K.Narayanan, former Director of Intelligence Bureau, delivered the 1st Amar Kapoor Memorial Lecture on 'Role of Intelligence in National Security' at an impressive function held in Jammu on Feb 05. The function, organized by

the J&K Police in memory of late Shri Amar Kapoor, Addl. Director General, was presided over by the Chief Minister, Dr Farooq Abdullah. In an extensive lecture, Shri Narayanan stated that if the intelligence is to emerge as the drive-wheel of new modern security system, it must embark upon the task of educating and equipping intelligence personnel as also updating their skills to tackle the challenges. The outcome of tomorrow's cyber conflict will depend upon how well intelligence agencies understand and pre-empt the efforts of antagonists who apply most advance technologies. He emphasized that the intelligence agencies, who need to be more relevant, must ensure the legitimacy of their product and should possess a keen insight about the changes taking place within and outside the country. Hereafter, the intelligence spy-glass will

require to be focussed not only on the ideological and territorial threats of an earlier period but also at the new engines of instability like religious, ethnic, sub-national and fundamental tensions and growing dimensions of modern covert warfare. He also cautioned against the threats of proxy war and terrorism which are rapidly undergoing a mutation.

In his address, the Chief Minister, Dr Farooq Abdullah paid rich tributes to late Shri Amar Kapoor, who served the state police and the Intelligence Bureau with distinction. An officer of 1964 batch of Indian Police Services, Shri Kapoor had the

distinction of leading the State intelligence network and Vigilance organisation. Dr Abdullah described Shri Kapoor as a brilliant and professional Police officer whose memory will never fade.

Earlier, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, DGP paid tributes to Shri Kapoor and introduced the speaker to the audience. Senior civil, Army and police officers besides a galaxy of academicians, mediemen and prominent citizens of the state were present. A lively question-answer session helped to bring out various facets of challenges before intelligence agencies.

WELFARE SCHEME LAUNCHED BY DGP

For the rehabilitation of the families of Police personnel killed while fighting militancy, a welfare scheme 'SAVERA' was launched formally by Shri Gurbachan Jagat, DGP, J&K on Feb 06. A meeting of Deputy Superintendents of Police of each district in J&K, who have been designated as nodal officers at the district level for implementing the rehabilitation scheme, was addressed by Director General of Police. The scheme envisages gazetted Police officers visiting families of the martyrs periodically and obtaining details of the dependents and getting first hand information about their conditions. The DGP emphasized the need for developing a sympathetic attitude towards the families of the deceased Police personnel and do whatever is possible for their welfare.

Earlier, Shri Gopal Sharma, IGP Hqrs. and Dr Ashok Bhan, IG Armed Police described the implementation of the scheme to the nodal officers. The scheme will be extended to Police personnel killed in harness and retired police personnel also.

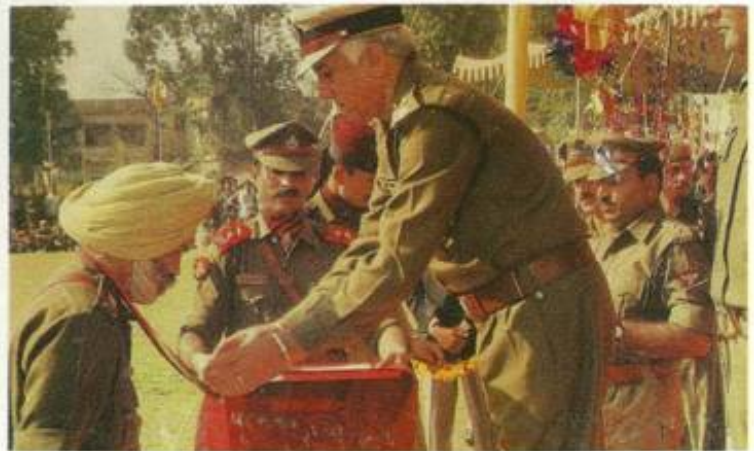
INVESTITURE CEREMONY OF DGPs COMMENDATION MEDAL

HIGHLIGHTS OF ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS BY J&K POLICE

★ J&K Police gunned down 3 hardcore militants in an operation at village Nar in Mendhar area of district Poonch on Feb 17. Two of the slain militants have been identified as Khalid Bhai @ Fouji, who was chief of ISI operational network in Mendhar,

and Kausar Khan, Area Commander of Hizbul Mujahideen militant outfit for Mendhar. One pika gun, one AK-47 rifle, one wireless set and explosives were recovered from the slain militants.

★ The district Commander of Hizbul Mujahideen for Poonch, Col. Mousa, and the Area Commander of Surankote, Jahangir Khan, were killed in an encounter with Special Task Force of

J&K Police in Mendhar area on Feb 12.

★ Anantnag Police eliminated a top Harkat-ul-Mujahideen militant identified as Abass Malik on Feb 22.

★ Two mercenaries were killed in a joint operation by BSF and Special Operation Group of J&K Police in the upper reaches of Gool in Udhampur district on Feb 24. Two AK-47 rifles and ammunition were recovered from the possession of the slain militants. In yet another encounter between the militants and Army and Special Operation Group of J&K Police in Thatri area of Gandoh in Doda district, 2 more militants were killed and a large quantity of arms and ammunition recovered.
