2nd Amar Kapoor Memorial Lecture

Shri Prakash Singh, former Director General Border Security Force (BSF), delivered the key note address on "Low intensity conflicts and high intensity crime" at an impressive function held in Jammu on Feb 25. The function, organised by J&K Police in memory of Late Shri Amar Kapoor, Additional Director General of Police, was attended by academicians, media personalities and prominent citizens of the State and was presided over by the Chief Minister, Dr. Farooq Abdullah. Shri Prakash Singh elaborated on the subject with reference to his long experience in dealing with the insurgency in North-East and also in J&K and Punjab. He presented valuable suggestions in dealing with Kashmir militancy which include choking of the supply line of militants from across the border and containing infiltration and exfiltration for which the fencing of the border was an important ingredient. Shri Singh held that the Kashmir problem had metamorphosed from a territorial dispute between two nations to a battle between Pak based Islamic fundamentalists and secular India.

In his address, the Chief Minister

Dr. Farooq Abdullah paid rich tributes to late Amar Kapoor and described him as an upright police officer with courage, determination and humanity. The Chief Minister said the leadership of the country

speedily and by understanding each others views and aspirations, the country will become strong, the Chief Minister hoped.

Earlier, the Director General of J&K Police, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, in his welcome address, spoke about the contributions of former Additional Director General of Police, Late Shri Amar Kapoor, who served the state police and intelligence bureau with distinction. An officer of the 1964 batch of Indian Police Service, Late Shri Kapoor, had the distinction of leading the state intelligence organisation and vigilance organisation, whose memory will never fade, the DGP added.

Additional Director General of Police, Armed, Shri Gopal Sharma, presented the vote of thanks while paying tributes to Late Shri Amar Kapoor.

Achievements in Anti militancy

- In a joint operation conducted by district police Budgam and Army, two foreign mercenaries identified as Syed Rehman @ abu Jana and Abu Zarar, both Pakistani nationals, were gunned down in Chadoora area on Feb. 04.
- A top militant of Harkat-ul-Jehad Islami (HUJI) identified as Javed Iqbal Lone code named Noor Hussain, was killed on Feb 6 in an encounter at

Padyarna (Doda) by a joint party of task force of state police and 26 RR. One AK 56 Rifles, 2 Chinese grenade and a wireless set were recovered from the site of encounter.

- A Hizbul Mujahidin (HM) militant, identified as Javed Hussain, involved in series of explosions in Reasi town, was arrested by Reasi police on Feb. 6. Two grenades were recovered from his possession.

- A militant was gunned down by Police and Village Defence Committee (VDC) members in Chowki

Choura area of Akhnoor (Jammu) on

Feb. 17, one Chinese Pistol and ammunition were recovered from the slain militant.

- Police recovered a huge cache of weapons and ammunition including 20 kgs RDX and a sniper Rifle in a search operation in Ramkote forest area near Manser on Feb. 7.
- On Feb 26, a militant was killed by SOG Poonch in Guran Payeen area of Lamberi during and encounter.
