### HIGH LEVEL MEETING IN SRINAGAR

**WE MUST MAINTAIN VIGIL AGAINST ENEMIES OF PEACE AND FRUSTRATE THEIR DESIGNS: CM**

Stressing on the need for greater coordination between various Forces, engaged in fighting militancy, the Chief Minister said that the common objective is to help return peace in the state. "Every body knows that Pakistan is investing heavily to obstruct and derail our peace initiative but our task is to thwart its designs and meet people's yearning for peace", he added.

The Chief Minister impressed upon all the 'Forces' to cultivate people-friendly image which shall help improving the situation on the ground. "While you should be soft on innocents, you have to be firm against those indulging in killings and violence", he reiterated.

The Chief Minister discussed measures to check infiltration from across the border and impressed upon the participants to maintain constant vigil.

### FOUNDATION STONE OF FSL BLOCK

Shri A.K. Suri, Director General of Police, J&K, laid the foundation stone of the annexe block of Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) near Bikram Chowk, Jammu, on April 03.

The annexe block, being constructed at an estimated cost of Rs. 45 Lakhs, shall be dust proof and air-conditioned. This shall house the divisions of Serology, Documents, Finger Prints, DNA Laboratory, Instruments, X-Ray Diffraction, Gas Chromatography, Electron Microscopy, Polygraphy, Voice Identification, Photography, Cyber Crime and the library.

## SUCCESSES IN ANTI MILITANCY OPS

- ◆ Chief Commander operations of Hiz bul Mujahideen outfit, Saif-ul-Islam was shot dead in a joint operation by BSF and J&K Police in Nowgam area of Srinagar on April 2. A huge amount of cash, AK 56 rifle and a pistol were recovered from the slain militant.
- ◆ Police and Army, in a joint operation, destroyed two hideouts of the militants in Haribudha area in Poonch District on April 02. Six hard core terrorists, all foreign mercenaries, belonging to J-e-M (Jaish-e-Mohammad) outfit, were also eliminated. 6 AK rifles, 18 magazines and 3 wireless sets were recovered from the scene of encounter.
- ◆ 3 HM militants were killed in a joint operation by the troops of ITBP and state Police during the intervening night of April 27 & 28 in Lagota forest area in Gundoh tehsil of district Doda.
- ◆ 6 Terrorists belonging to HM outfit were made to surrender, with a cache of weapons including 6 AK type rifles, 21 AK magazines, 686 rounds, two wireless sets and huge quantity of grenades and IEDs, by Doda Police on April, 19.
- ◆ A district Commander of J-e-M outfit whose identity was established as Abu Haris, a foreign mercenary, was gunned down in an encounter, jointly launched by police and the Army in Surankote area of Poonch district on April, 18. One AK rifle, 3 magazines, 71 rounds of ammunition and one wireless set were recovered from the slain militant.
- ◆ The district Commander of L-e-T outfit, identified as Zia Mustaffa, who had planned the Nadimarag massacre of March 23, was arrested by police on April 10.
- ◆ In a joint operation, police and security forces busted a hideout of militants at Gulathi Forest area in Manjkote in Rajouri District. One A.K. 56 rifle with two magazines & 60 rounds, one UBGL, three rifle grenades, explosive material, nine detonators, IEDs, 5 anti personal mines, Hand grenade and one bag was recovered from the said hideout.
