THE COMMITMENT AND CONVICTION OF J&K POLICE IS SECOND TO NONE : CM J&K

Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister has complimented the J&K Police by saying that "in commitment and conviction, JKP is second to none." He has also expressed hope in that J&K Police will be sought like CRPF and BSF to tackle difficult situations in various parts of the country as it has emerged as a vibrant force to reckon with, in recent years.

Speaking on the occasion of attestation cum passing out parade of the 15th batch, comprising 944 recruits constables including 173 females, at Prithinandan Singh Police Training School Kathua on April 26, the Chief Minister said that J&K Police has to its credit many successes in combating militancy. The excellence achieved, over the years, has to be maintained and new goals set to herald a new direction for the force, the Chief Minister added. Expressing gratitude to the officers and men of J&K police, who sacrificed their lives for the security and integrity of the country, the Chief Minister said, "we salute our martyrs for scripting a saga of valour and maintaining glorious traditions." Exhorting police personnel to maintain the well earned reputation of bravery, the Chief Minister hoped that they will not dither from the path of impartiality while dealing with the situations and protecting civil population. "Treat a criminal and anti-national element as per law, No matter he is a friend or relative." Dr. Farooq Abdullah added.

Earlier, the Chief Minister took salute at an impressive march past, who also inspected the parade alongwith MOS (Home) Shri M.A. Lone and the DGP J&K Shri A.K. Suri.

Shri Sham Lal S. P, Principal of the training school, administered oath to recruit constables.

Speaking on the occasion the DGP said that since a police constable is found at every place and interacts with various shades of people, it is he, who builds the image of police. He stressed on the importance of police-public relations and exhorted police personnel to further strengthen this relationship by their sympathetic and helpful attitude. He impressed upon the police to serve the people in right earnest and refrain from doing any thing which may belittle and stigmatise their profession. He also complimented the recruits for their fine turn out and drill.

Lady constable Sunita Verma was declared all-round best cadet and also stood first in indoor subject got one rank promotion. Recruit constable Mohd Rafiq and constable Rajinder Singh secured 2nd and 3rd position respectively, in indoor subject. Constable Joginder Paul was declared best in range classification followed by constable Narinder Singh and Lady Constable Sushma Sharma (both 2nd) and constable Bashir Ahmed, Lady Constable Nisha Kumari and constable Mohan Lal (all 3rd) in range classification. Constable Tufail Hussain secured first position in outdoor performance, whereas constable Sham Lal and constable Sansar Singh stood 2nd and 3rd respectively.

J&K POLICE IS GRADUALLY BECOMING A MODEL POLICE FORCE : CM J&K.

- Talking to the media on April 19, after the investiture ceremony at Raj Bhawan, Dr. Farooq Abdullah said that J&K Police is gradually becoming a model Police force and the day is not very far when other states would requisition J&K Police to handle difficult law and order situations.
- Everything possible is being done for modernising the state Police by providing it sophisticated weaponry, mobility and communication besides looking after housing needs to further improve its efficiency, the C.M. added, in reply to a question by the mediaperson.
- The Chief Minister gave out that the central government has agreed to State Government's proposal to increase the ex-gratia for Policemen killed in anti-militancy operations from Rs. 02 lakhs to Rs. 05 lakhs.

08-day long (April, 18-25) J&K Police Inter Zone Sports Meet was held in Jammu in which 6 zones of J&K Police took part. The events of the Tournament were Athletics, Football, Hockey, Kabaddi, Tug of war, Volley ball, Table tennis, Badminton and Lawn tennis.

Shri Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, who was the chief guest at the inaugural function, took salute from the participant contingents on April 18.

Speaking on the inaugural function, after having declared open the Sports Meet at the Gulshan ground, Jammu, the Chief Minister expressed his satisfaction over the excellence of police sports personnel of the state in various National /International events. He asked the DGP to explore the possibilities of introducing skiing, Mountaineering and water-sports events in the sports curricula. A proposal to merge Auxiliary Police with Armed Police is pending before the state Government and is likely to be cleared soon, which shall widen promotion prospects of the Auxiliary Police personnel and the issue of stagnation confronting the Auxiliary Police will come to an end, the DGP said amidst cheers.

The raising day function concluded with a colourful cultural programme and *Bara-Khana* in the evening.

POLICE RESPOND TO THE OBLIGATIONS IMPOSED UPON THEM.

To accept responsibility and to carry out duties in a manner most conducive to the public good, J&K Police, in Kashmir Valley, has set for itself a 05-points programme for the year 2001, to usher in a new era of Police-Public relationship. This is aimed at cultivating healthy Police-Public relations, emphasised on the Officers and men of J&K Police by the Director General of Police, Shri A.K. Suri.

Dr. A.K. Bhan IGP, Kashmir Zone, Srinagar, in an interview to the press on April 05, identified the core areas and said that Police have to be sensitive to how people react to their actions. The 5-points programme, emphasised for all Police Stations across the Valley, is an effort directed towards raising the professional status of Police work and rendering service to the community in a clean and efficient manner, A.K. Bhan added.

5-POINT PROGRAMME

- Tracing of crimes committed by militants, particularly killings of innocent civilians;
- Prevention and detection of property related offences including automobile thefts and burglaries;
- Prevention of extortions;
- To ensure that no collateral damage to the property and person is caused and public is not harassed during police actions;
- Educating people to prevent fresh recruitment into militant ranks.

MAJOR SUCCESSES IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS

- 7 foreign militants of Lashkar-e-Toiba outfit, identified as Mohd Yaqoob @ Abu Saifullah, Abu Adil, Abu Bilal, Umar Bhai, Sartaj Bhai, Shabbaz Bhai and Abdul Bhai, all Pak nationals, were eliminated in a fierce day-long battle near Ding Amb (Kathua) by a joint operation team of local Police, SOG, CRPF and Army. A huge quantity of weapons including one Pika gun, 8 AK-rifles and one Pistol were recovered from the slain militants.
- 10 militants were gunned down in a joint operation by SOG, Police, Army and BSF at village Morha (Rajouri) on April 16.
- 4 hitmen of Jaish-e-Mohd militant outfit including Hameed Kishwari, District Commander of the outfit, were eliminated in Warwan area of district Doda with the back up of Rashtriya rifles on April 05.
- 3 militants identified as Izatullah @ Col. Zaki, district commander of Lashka-e-Toiba outfit, Mohd Azam Rubani Code 11, group commander of LeT, both Pak nationals and Tahir Sidiq were eliminated by a joint operation party of J&K Police and the Army in Nangli forests (Rajouri) on April 17.
- Special Operations Group, Baramulla, with back up of Rashtriya Rifles, eliminated 2 HM militants, identified as Ubaid Hussain and Bashir Ahmed, during the search operation at a militant hideout at Cheernar (Spore) on April 07.
- Three militants of Lashkar-e-Toiba militant outfit were gunned down by SOG, Doda, on April 13 in Marwah area. One of them was identified as Abu Usman, commander of LeT for Marwah.
