J&K POLICE SPORTS MEET-2002

650 players participated in the J&K Police Interzone Sports Meet -2002, which was held in Jammu (April 08-14). Addressing a meeting of DIsG and district Ss P of Jammu Zone, on April, 15, the DGP, J&K, stressed on the need

to further strengthen the Police-Public ties with a view to share and address the problems and concern of the masses. SUCCESSSES IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS:

⊙ In a joint operation by special operation Group (SOG), Baramulla and RR, a hardcore Lashkar-e-Tobia militant, indentified as Muzaffar Hayat @ Khalid, a native of Pakistan, was eliminated in Baramulla district on April, 04. In yet another operation, lanchd by Army and SOG jointly, 2 militants identified as Ab Waheed Bhat belonging to Lashkar-e-Tobia outfit were eliminated at Dachipora, Shopian.

⊙ SOG Baramulla, with the back up from Security forces, eliminated 04 militants identified as Abdual Rehman @ ubidullah, Self-styled supreme commander of Harkat-ul-Jehad Islami (HUJI), Nadeem @ Altamash, Dy. district commander of Jaish-e-Mohd (JeM), Gouri and Ab. Rehman @ Abu Harraira, both belonging to HUJI militant outfit, on April, 13, at village Chitamar (Bandipura). 04 AK-47 rifles, 02 wireless sets, 05 grenades, 07 UBGL grenades, 08 Anti-Tank rockets and 10 kgs. of explosives were recovered from the salin militants.

⊙ On April 21, J&K Police and Army, in a joint operation, eliminated 05 hardcore militants, identified as Bashir Ahmed @ Sadiq, Section Commander of Hizbul Mujahideen, Gul Mohd. @ Ishfaq, Mehmood @ Langda, Farooq Ahmed, Suhial and Ab. Gaffar, in Doda district.

⊙ In a joint operation by Army and J&K Police, 06 unidentified foreign mercenaries of Jaish-e-Mohd militant outfit, were eliminated at village Sathra (Mandi, Poonch) on April, 26.

⊙ Poonch Police and Army, in a joint operation, eliminated a hardcore terrorist, identified as Khalid Afghani, the operational chief of Jaish-e-Mohd (JeM) militant organization, at village Milan, Surankote (Poonch).
