J&K POLICE FULLY GEARED UP TO ROOT-OUT MILITANCY IN J&K

In its continued drive against militancy the special operations Group (SOG) of J&K Police eliminated 44 top ranking militants including foreign mercenaries, during the first quarter of current year, in various encounters. Those eliminated included Yousuf Talha, a Pak national, Divisional Commander of *Lashkar-e-Toiba (LET)*, Ghulam Mohi-ud-Din Najar,

organiser of *Lashkar-e-Toiba (LET)*, Hamid Gadda @ Bamber Khan, Divisional Commander of *Hizbul Mujahideen (HM)*, Ghulam Mohd, Chief of *Hizbul Mujahideen (HM)* for Kupwara district, Mohd Maqbool, Divisional Commander of *TUJ*, Nisar Ullah Malik, Divisional Commander of *Hizbul Mujahideen (HM)*, Niyaz Ahmed, Chief of *Islamic Front*, Mansoor, a native of Rawalpindi (Pak), Launching Chief of *HUM*, Fayaz Ahmed @ Nasir, Launching Chief of *HM*, Mehraj-ud-Din Hafiz @ Feroz @ Shabir @ Shafi, Chief of

Jammu Police successfully worked out the bomb explosions that occurred in Sealdah and Pooja Express, a Video Coach in Punjab, Bus stand, Jammu and Sabzi Mandi near Science College, Jammu by apprehending the perpetrators belonging to *Khalistan Zindabad Force (KZF)* and *Islamic Front* outfits. With the arrest of these militants, the structure of the two outfits, who were operating for the last few months, has been shattered.

Infiltration bids were foiled by Kathua Police along the International Border and three infiltrators were gunned down. Separate encounters in Samba and Udhampur resulted in elimination of intruding mercenaries and guides from across.

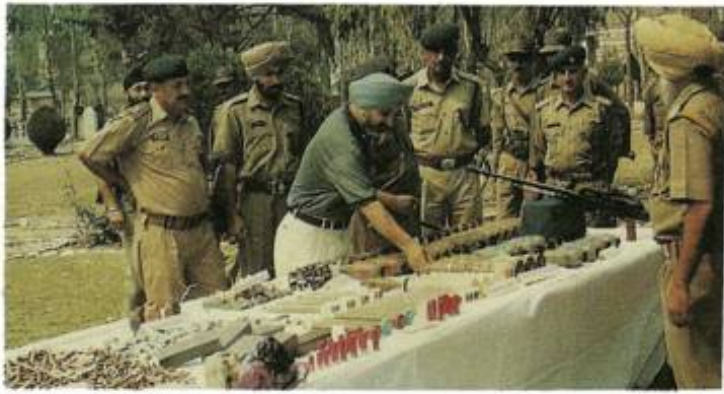
Acting on the intelligence inputs that Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI) has pushed in large

consignment of Weapons, through its mercenaries and dumped it in Kalaban and Shindra top of Poonch district, a massive search and combing operations was launched by the local Police with the association of SOG

and CRPF. A huge dump of Weapons and explosives including Twelve 82 mm H.E. Bombs, Twenty 60 mm H.F. Bombs, 29 RPG Medium Rackets, 15 Hand

Grenades, 50 kgs of RDX, 2 grenade launchers, 2 Anti- Personnel Mines, 30 IEDs, 118 RPG rockets, 13 Radio remote control devices, 2 flame throwers and 1160 cartridges were recovered on April 10.

Dr Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister, J&K while describing it as a major achievement of Police, announced a cash reward of Rs 5 Lakhs for the team which effected the recoveries. He also inspected the cache of weapons and explosive on April 13.
