### HOMAGE TO POLICE MARTYRS

On Oct. 21, 41st Annual Police Commemoration Day was observed throughout the State with the renewed commitment to wipe-out militancy and bring back peace and tranquillity.

The State Level function was held in the J&K Armed Police Complex at Zewan, Srinagar. Shri. M.A. Lone, MOS (Home), was the chief guest.

Shri Mubarak Gul, Legislators, senior serving and retired Police Officers, Civil Officers, prominent citizens and a large number of Police Personnel were present on the occasion.

While paying homage to the martyrs, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of J&K Police, read out the names of 1249 officers and *jawans* killed in action over the past one year, across the country. The martyred officers and *jawans* belonged to different states, BSF, CRPF, ITBP and other central forces. These included 126 Police Officers and *jawans* of J&K Police who sacrificed their lives while fighting militancy and discharging their duties. Shri Gurbachan Jagat, DGP stressed on the need to keep the morale and fighting spirit of the force and called for provision of liberal grants for welfare contributory Fund and modernisation/up-gradation of police.

Shri M.A. Lone, MOS (Home) paid rich tributes to the officers and *Jawans* who sacrificed their lives for the security and integrity of the country. Speaking on the

occasion, he said that our efforts will continue to restore peace in the State and there will be no let-up in the fight against militancy.

### **RECRUITMENT DRIVE IN GANDERBAL (SGR)**

200 constables were recruited in an on-the-spot Special Recruitment Drive by Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, at two remote villages of Ganderbal on Oct. 24.

Shri Omar Abdullah, Union Minister of State for Industries and Commerce visited the village Salina (Ganderbal) and met some of the candidates who appeared in the test. He expressed satisfaction over the results of the Special recruitment drives being undertaken by the J&K Police.

A similar recruitment drive was held in the downtown area of Parimpora in Srinagar city on

October. 23 in which 106 constables were recruited on the spot. The recruitment was supervised by the Director General of Police and Chief Minister J&K, Dr. Farooq Abdullah was also present.

### **POLICE PUBLIC CALL OFFICE INAUGURATED**

A Police public call office with STD facility was inaugurated by Shri Gopal Sharma, Addl. Director General of Police, Armed, J&K on Oct. 10, at Gulshan Ground, Jammu. The PCO is run by the Police Departmental Store, Jammu.

The Police Departmental Store, Jammu, came into existence on Jan. 06, 1996 with a capital investment of

Rs. 5 lakhs, advanced by the Police Hqrs. as loan. The loan advanced by the Police Hqrs. has since been remitted and the Departmental store has earned a net profit of Rs. 30,25042.00. The Police Departmental Store runs JKP Gas agency and has so far issued 9239 connections to subscribers. It also caters to the requirement of cooking gas for training centres and various Police formations in Jammu.

Yet another STD/PCO was inaugurated by Shri. Radhavinod Raju, IGP Jammu Zone, in district Police Lines, Jammu on Oct. 17.

### **COMPLAINT CARD SYSTEM INTRODUCED BY TRAFFIC WING OF J&K POLICE**

With a view to redress the complaints of the commuters, Traffic wing of J&K Police has introduced complaint cards. These complaint cards are available with all Traffic Officers and any commuter can register his complaint in the card for seeking the redressal of his grievances. 6716 Auto Rickshaw drivers have been challaned for non-use of meters and over charging from Jan to Oct. 2000.

In its continuous drive against environmental Pollution and consumer grievances, 5219 erring drivers were booked from Jan to Oct. 2000.

From Jan. to Oct. 2000, 1,62,323 drivers have been booked by the traffic Police for violations of Motor

Vehicle Act/Rules and an amount of Rs. 2.3 crores has been realised as fine from the erring drivers.

### **CID PERSONNEL PROMOTED OUT OF TURN**

Selection Grade Constables Niyaz Ahmed No.3376/C.I.D. and Mehraj-Ud-Din No. 1345/C.I.D. were promoted out of turn as Head Constables by the Director General of Police, J&K, on Oct. 21 and Oct. 24 respectively, in recognition of their outstanding performance in collection and dissemination of information leading to the recovery of huge cache of weapons and ammunitions in Poonch district.

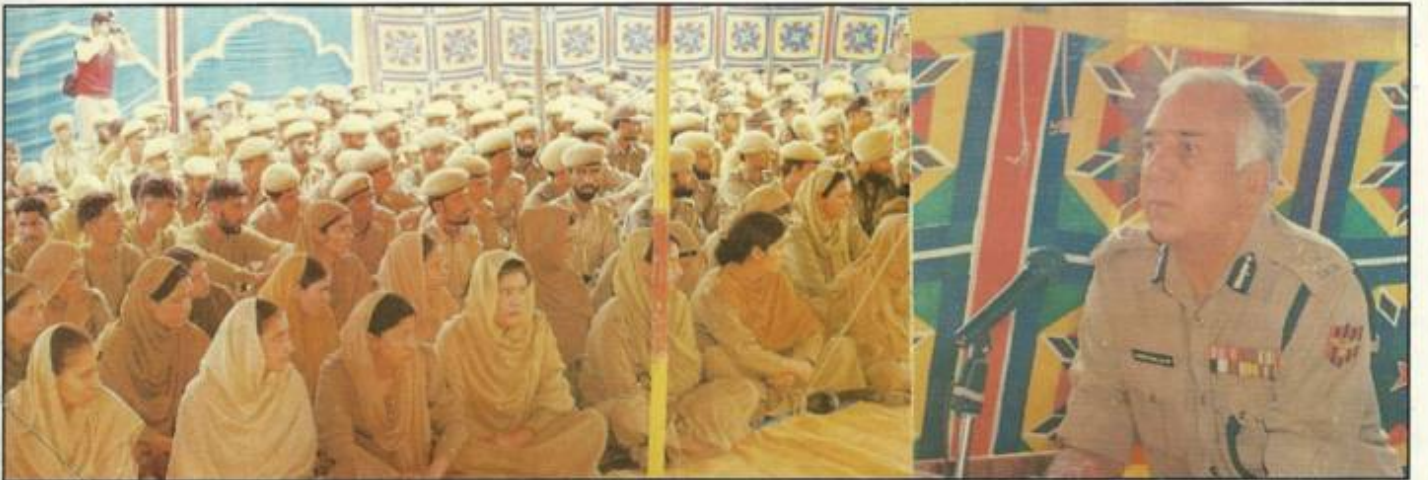
