MILITANCY TO BE OVER SOON - DGP

Shri Gurbachan Jagat, Director General of Police, J&K, in an interview (Sept.9), disclosed that massive offensive against militants would be launched during the next 4 months so that peace returns to the State. Showing his satisfaction over the performance of Special Operations Groups and praising the commendable job done by Army and para-military forces in crushing militancy, the DGP announced that the whole police force is gearing up fast to give a final blow to the militancy. Shri Jagat showed his desire that the Police should eventually fight militancy independently replacing the Army and BSF, in a phased manner.

Earlier, the DGP paid a whirlwind visit (Sept.6) to border Police Stations of Palanwalla, Khour and Jourian where he met respectables and a large number of locals to assess the situation. Thereafter, the DGP announced creation of a new border police district with Headquarters at R.S.Pura and spread over the districts of Kathua and Jammu with Dr Kamal Saini as its Chief. This step will strengthen

border policing and help maintain a strict vigil along the international border in the two districts. Steps have already been taken to procure and provide adequate transport, arms and ammunition, bomb disposal equipment and communication facilities for the border district.

In another meeting presided over by the DGP (Sept.6), it was decided to intensify anti-militancy operations in Gool, Mahore, Latti, Basantgarh and areas of Doda district by strengthening Special Task Forces and Village Defence Committees. IGP Jammu Zone, Shri Kuldeep Khuda, DIG Doda Range, Shri K.Rajindra and other senior Police Officers attended the meeting.

CHIEF MINISTER COMPLIMENTS J&K POLICE

Dr Farooq Abdullah, Chief Minister of J&K, has complimented the J&K Police for reviving sports activity in Kashmir Valley after 8 years. Dr Abdullah was presiding over the closing ceremony of Inter Zone Police Tournament at Bakshi Stadium on Sept.24.

The Chief Minister, in his address, outlined the importance of physical growth amongst the men in uniform. He expressed his confidence that good sportsmen will be produced and teams from the State would excel in national level games in future. He announced a grant of Rs.2 lakhs for Police Sports Fund and cash prizes of Rs.5000/- each for contingents of Auxiliary/Telecommunication Range and lady's contingent for their excellent performance during march-past.

Welcoming the Chief Minister, the Director General of Police, Shri Gurbachan Jagat said that the revival of sports was an indicator of the J&K Police getting activated in all the spheres - be it prevention and detection of crime, anti-militancy operations or participation in or promotion of sports amongst youth in the Valley. He complimented the efforts of Shri S.S. Ali, Addl.DGP Armed Police, in motivating school and college going youth in the valley in participating in various tournaments and coaching camps.

Among those present on the occasion were Dr Mustaffa Kamal, Minister for Health and Medical Education, Shri Abdul Qayoom, Minister for Education, Shri Ashok Jaitley, Chief Secretary, several legislators and senior Civil and Police Officers. The Chief Minister's All-round Best Trophy was won by Armed Police and DGP's Runners-up Trophy went to Jammu Zone. Auxiliary/Telecommunication Zone won the Tug of War finals played before the audience. ASI Ghulam Mohd., HC Talib Hussain Shah, HC Shahnawaz and SG Ct. Ghulam Rasool received best player's trophies in Football, Volleyball, Kabaddi and Hockey, respectively.

The Inter-Zonal Games were inaugurated on Sept.22 by Chief Secretary, Shri Ashok Jaitley. The Chief Secretary, while appreciating various successes achieved by J&K Police in antimilitancy operations, reiterated the Government's resolve to modernise the Police force by improving weaponry, communications and transport aiming at making J&K Police one of the best in the country as visualised by the Chief Minister. Shri I.S.Malhi, ACS (Home) and senior Police Officers attended the inaugural function.

POLICE WELFARE FUND COMMITTEE MEETING



A meeting of the Central Police Welfare Fund Committee was held at Armed Police Complex Zewan on Sept.25. DGP Shri Gurbachan Jagat, presided over the meeting which was attended by representatives of various units and Senior Police Officers. The forum was utilized to discuss various issues related to welfare of Policemen so that senior level management is able to ascertain the views of officials of various ranks and different units for incorporation in policy formulation. It was decided to set up a group to present the case of Police department regarding the grade revision before the State Pay Committee. The power of the Central Welfare Committee to grant relief was increased from Rs.10,000/- to 15,000/and reimbursement of spectacles charges from Rs.150/- to 300/-. It was decided that a relief of Rs.5000/- out of Central Retired Policemen Welfare Fund shall be paid to NOK of retired policemen at the time of their death. Welfare loan will now be granted for the marriage of a sister also. A suggestion that residential plots should be reserved for recipients of gallantry medal will be referred to the Government. It was decided to increase the retirement gift to Rs.2000/-. Copies of J&K Police Manual will be got printed and made available to Police Stations and Police Offices. A bus service between Jammu and Srinagar, 3 times a week, will be introduced. To meet a long standing need, Government will again be requested for establishing a separate Police Funds Office for better maintenance of G.P.F. records.

POLICE HOUSING CORPORATION SET UP

A Police Housing Corporation to construct Office and residential accommodation for J&K Police has been set up with Shri Madan Lal, IGP, designated as its Managing Director. The Corporation with

a total outlay of Rs.100 Crores for the next five years, is expected to improve satisfaction level in housing of policemen and give a better look to the Police Stations and other Police complexes.

MOS HOME REVIEWS SECURITY

Minister of State for Home, Shri Ali Mohammad Sagar, reviewed the security scenario in Budgam district on Sept.19. Shri Sagar appreciated the efforts of J&K Police in gradually taking over various responsibilities and performing law and order duties. He advised those involved in counter insurgency operations to deal with common people humanely while acting firmly against armed militants. Shri Sagar stressed on the need for a better understanding and coordination between various agencies. The meeting amongst others was attended by Shri R.Tikoo, IGP CID and Shri P.S. Gill, IGP Kashmir Zone.

SEMINAR ON COMBATING MILITANCY

A seminar was held on Sept.23 to discuss the present security scenario and combating of residual militancy with special reference to the role of J&K Police. DGP J&K presided and senior Police Officers participated in the seminar. Shri R.Tikoo, IGP CID, presented the theme paper on which discussions were held.

It was widely felt that in the existing system of coordination between various forces, representatives of the people should also be co-opted. Tracing of heinous militancy related crimes by police can go a long way in improving our credibility and weakening the adversary. A need was felt for launching of counter propaganda against the mischievous Pakistani designs. There was a consensus that important towns can gradually be taken over by local police assisted by CRPF but rural areas will need continued operations by Army and Para-military forces. The seminar also highlighted need for attention in border areas of Jammu Province particularly districts of Poonch and Rajouri.

TOP MILITANT KILLED BY SOG

The Special Operations Group of Srinagar district killed top Tehreek-ul-Mujahideen militant, Mohd. Haneef Dar in an encounter on Sept.7. The slain militant was involved in killing of TV journalist, Svedain Shafi and many other innocent people.
