09 J&K POLICE PERSONNEL ATTAIN MARTYRDOM

of the people and bringing glory to the force they belonged to. Yet another rare example of sacrifice, dedication and devotion to duty by J&K Police, in which 9 Police Personnel were martyred, was demonstrated on Aug. 10.

On August 10, an explosion took place near the State Bank of India in the Regal Chowk area of Srinagar City. Following the blast the policemen including Shri Kuldeep Sharma, SDPO Kothibagh and Shri Altaf Ahmed, SHO Kothibagh rushed to the spot to assess the situation and to take necessary security measures, least caring that another blast that could follow and bring down curtains on their lives. A powerful car bomb explosion took place which claimed the lives of 9 policemen of J&K Police. The martyred Police Personnel were **Shri Kuldeep Sharma**, Dy. S.P, **Shri Mohd. Altaf**, Inspector, **Shri Mohd. Yaqoob**, Sub-Inspector, SG Const. **Ravinder Kumar**, Constable **Nisar Ahmed**, Constable **Jan Mohd**, Constable **Naseer Ahmad**, Constable **Bodh Raj** and Constable Driver **Imtiyaz Ahmed**. Shri Pankaj Kumar, IPS, SP (East) Srinagar was among the seriously injured in the blast.

On behalf of the officers and men of the J&K Police, the Editorial Board of J&K Police News letter salute the memory of the martyrs.

A RARE ACT OF BRAVERY

On August 01, an unidentified militant lobbed grenades in the premises of Hari Singh High School, Jammu, where a registration centre for Shri Amarnathji Yatrics had been established.

Demonstrating a rare act of bravery, the Policemen deployed for the security of the Pilgrims, retaliated and gunned down the militant and averted a major tragedy. One AK 56 Rifle, 4 magazines, 45 rounds, one ammunition pouch, one mask and Rs. 10,000/- (Indian Currency) was recovered from the slain militant.

HIGHLIGHTS OF EVENTS

- ◆ The daily "State Times" announced a reward of Rs. 5000/- to constable Krishan Lal for his rare act of bravery in gunning down a militant on Aug. 01.
- ◆ The government have sanctioned three more Battalions of J&K Police to strengthen it to meet the challenges it faces.

- ✦ Lakhanpur Police arrested three smugglers and seized 25 kgs. of contraband charas on Aug. 17.
- ✦ 73 SIs of executive Police were promoted as inspectors on August 19.
- ✦ A meeting under the mass contact programme was held at Police Station, Udhampur on August 21 in which prominent citizens of the town participated. SSP Udhampur, Shri Satvir Gupta presided.

- ✦ Under the mass contact programme, a meeting was organised by the Police and Civil administration in Surankote on August 22. Shri Ram Lubhaya, DIG Poonch-Rajouri, chaired the meeting.
- ✦ 35 SsP were transferred in a mass Police reshuffle ordered by the Government on August 23.
- ✦ DGP J&K ordered out of turn promotions to 7 Police constables and regularisation of the services of 12 SPOs for their outstanding performance in anti-militancy operations during his visit to Poonch district on Aug.26.

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS OF J&K POLICE IN ANTI-MILITANCY OPERATIONS

- ✦ In a well coordinated and executed operation, Samba Police and the Army gunned down 2 Fidayeens (Suicide Squad Militants) in Basantar Nallah area on August 02. Weapons and ammunition including one AK-56 rifle and a pistol were recovered from the slain militants.
- ✦ Srinagar Police arrested 6 militants responsible for causing Car Bomb explosion of August 10. The arrested include 4 militants identified as Iqbal Khan @

Manzoor, Shafat Reshi @ Zubir, Haji Ali Mohd. and Abdul Hameed @ Hameed Cheeni, all belonging to Laksher-e-Toiba militant outfit.

- ✦ 4 dreaded militants were shot dead in a joint operation by Romeo Force and J&K Police in Village Madoon, Darhal, indistrict Rajouri on August 03.
- ✦ Two pakistani militants were killed at village sanyal near Bane Chak (Ramkote) in district Kathua district on August 09.
- ✦ A militant identified as Qayoom Lohar was eliminated in Rungwar Forest area of Lolab during a joint operation by SOG Kupwara and Rashtriya Rifles.
- ✦ 2 Pak mercenaries, identified as Abu Zubir and Abu Zarar, were eliminated in a joint operation by Handwara Police and Rashtriya Rifles on August 09.
- ✦ Loran Police (Poonch) busted a militant hideout in Doke Kullian and Thanda Ban area and recovered a huge cache of weapons and ammunition.
- ✦ Jammu Police arrested a dreaded Pak trained militant alongwith his 4 associates and recovered a cache of weapons and ammunition including an RDX filled IED fitted in Tiffin Box, a 4 kgs IED fitted in a domestic steel milt container, 4 Chinese pistols and a sophisticated wireless set.

- ✦ 4 Lakshar-e-Toiba hideouts were smashed in Kasbalari forest area of Rajouri district on August 02. A cache of arms and explosives recovered from the hideouts included 2 HE missiles, 5 solar missiles, 50 kgs RDX, 20 RPGs, 2 Smoke bombs, 24 Rocket boosters and 5 sealed boxes of AK ammunition.
