- Ab Rashid Khan @ chacha @ Moulvi Sahib @Bhai Sahib, a notorious ISI guide was killed in an encounter between militants and Police at Bein Nallah in Hira Nagar tehsil of Kathua district on August 25.
- 2 Militants hailing from Pakistan were gunned down by SOG Jammu near Village Attar Singh in Satwari of district Jammu on August 20.
- 02 militants including the Divisional commander of Hizbul Mujahideen militant outfit were gunned down at Budshah Nagar, Natipora (Srinagar) on August 18 by a joint search party of SOG and BSF

MAJOR SUCCESSES IN ANTI-MILITANCY

- 04 foreign mercenaries, identified as Abu Gulam, Abu Zaffar, Abu Hussain and Rashid Khan, all natives of Pakistan, were gunned down in two separate encounters on August 07 in Kishtawar area of district Doda, in a joint operation by SOG of J&K Police and Army.
- 02 militants, believed to be foreigners, were eliminated at village Assarwah in Kanachak area of Jammu on August 08, by SOG Jammu. One AK rifle, a wireless Set and an IED were recovered from the slain militants.
- In a joint operation by SOG Bandipora and 15 RR, three militants were killed and 11 exfiltrators captured in Bandipora area of Baramulla district on August 07.
- 02 top wanted militants of Hizbul Mujahideen were gunned down at Krashbal, in Idgah outskirts of Srinagar, in an encounter with SOG and BSF.

- Poonch Police gunned down Abu Shahid, a Fidayeen commander and Mohd Bilal of Lashkar-e-Tobia militant outfit on August 25.
- A foreign mercenary identified as Nayeem Ahmed Khan @ Khalid of Rawal Pindi, Pakistan, was gunned down at Bonagam, Kunzer (Baramulla) on August 07 in a joint operation by SOG and Army.
- 02 Pakistani mercenaries were gunned down in Sandwan village in Pouni Chak area of district Jammu by Police on August 17. 03 Chinese pistols, 06 magazines and 3 knives were recovered from the slain militants.
