NATIONAL YOUTH CAMP ORGANISED

With a view to promoting fraternal relation and brotherhood, inculcating the spirit of national integration, communal harmony and humane attitude, preserving the social fabric of society and developing cohesion amongst various sections of the society, J&K Police sponsored and organized a National Youth Camp at Pahalgam in Kashmir valley, under the Civic Action Programme.

J&K Police sponsored and organized a 9-day (July 30 to August 07) National Youth Camp, in which 231 students including 41 from J&K, drawn from 22 educational institutions of the country, participated.
