FACE TERRORISM WITH COURAGE – CHIEF MINISTER.

Jammu & Kashmir Chief Minister, Dr. Farooq Abdullah, has exhorted the newly recruited constabulary of J&K Police to face terrorism with courage and wipe out this menace from the state. Dr. Abdullah reminded that in Punjab it was ultimately the local police which eliminated

terrorism and praised J&K Police for a series of successes in anti-militancy operations. Dr. Abdullah was speaking at a passing-out-parade of 811 recruit constables of India Reserve Battalions at Punjab Armed Police Complex in Jalandhar on August 8. He thanked Punjab Police for training the recruits of the state Police and hoped similar co-operation between the two Police forces will continue.

Earlier, the Director General of Punjab Police, Shri P.C. Dogra, welcomed Dr. Farooq Abdullah and stressed the need for close interaction between Police forces of Punjab and J&K to meet the common cause of security and solidarity of the nation. The Director General of J&K Police, Shri Gurbachan Jagat, the Addl. Director General of Punjab Armed Police, Shri M.S. Bhullar and Inspectors General of Jammu & Kashmir Police, Shri Rajan Bakhshi and Dr. Ashok Bhan, were present on the occasion.

Cadet constable Jaga Singh was declared the all -round- best trainee and given an out of turn promotion.

With the completion of training in Punjab, the task of raising of IR III and IR IV Battalions has been completed. IR III Battalion has its Hqrs. at Kupwara and IR IV Battalion at Reasi with Dr. B. Srinivas and Shri Satvir Gupta, respectively, as their Commandants.

HIZBUL MUJAHIDEEN ACTING SUPREME COMMANDER KILLED IN ENCOUNTER.

The Special Operations Group of J&K Police, in an encounter, killed Hizbul Mujahideen's top most commander in the State, Ali Mohd Dar @ Burhan-ud-Din Hijazi, on August 9. IGP Kashmir, Shri P.S.Gill, disclosed that during a search operation, based on specific information, a hideout in Shorgari Mohalla, Nawab Bazar, Srinagar was raided and the most wanted militant killed in the ensuing encounter. Ali Mohd Dar had visited Pakistan on a number of occasions and returned last in April 1997 to takeover as the Deputy Supreme Commander of the militant outfit. With this success, the SOG has broken the back of Hizbul Mujahideen, which was spearheading militancy in the State. 2 Ak Rifles, one Pistol, 2 HF wireless sets and 100 detonators were recovered from the site of encounter.

RAISING DAY OF JKAP XIII BATTALION

The raising day of JKAP XIII Bn. was celebrated at Draba, Poonch on August 26. A cultural programme and *Bara Khana* was organised with Shri K. Rajindera, DIG of Police, Poonch-Rajouri Range as the Chief guest.

The Battalion came into existence on August 26, 1998 and has since given a good account with a creditable performance at Hazratbal Shrine Complex in March 1996. The bravado of late Sub-Inspector, Shri Amanullah Khan, a recipient of Police Medal for gallantry, was remembered on this day.
