The samples not conforming to the functional requirements of the purchaser/tender requirements shall be rejected. Decision of Police department regarding acceptance/rejection of the samples shall be final.
- 18. Security deposit. The approved tenderers will have to supply the articles as per approved rate, approved sample and specification till the validity of the contract. They will have to furnish the security deposit @ 5% of the total value of the items contracted for and for DGS&D rate contract based supplies, the security deposit will be 2% in the shape of CDR/FDR issued by a nationalized/scheduled bank, at the time of signing of Deed of Agreement to ensure satisfactory performance of the equipment supplied, for warranty period from the date of acceptance of product. This security deposit will be released in due course after the expiry of specified warranty period/agreed contract. The charges on stamps etc. (cost of documents in totality) shall be borne by the supplier while executing the agreement. (No interest shall be paid by the purchased on the security deposit). J&K Govt rules for security deposit in respect of local SSI Units shall be applicable.

19. Guarantee/warranty.
