JOINING INSTRUCTIONS: BOMB DISPOSAL ADVANCE COURSE

1. **Aim** Bomb Disposal Advance Course is conducted for State Police, Central Police Organisation (CPO), Defence Service (DS) and other central Govt organisation for capacity building. The Course builds on knowledge gained during Bomb Disposal Basic Course.
2. **Course Duration** - Four weeks.
3. **Capacity** - 100 trainees.
4. **Frequency** - Once a year.
5. **Eligibility** The State Police Forces/ CAPFs / Defence services should detail a team of willing & eligible Gazetted Officers/ Commissioned officers, Sub - ordinate Officers/ JCOs, Assistant Commanders (SI / ASI) & Rangers (Head Constables/ Constables) for the course. The personnel detailed to undergo this course should meet the following criteria:-

(a) QR

(b) Mandatory Requirements

- (i) **Educational Qualification** Graduation for Central Police Organisation/ State Police and Matriculation for Defence Services. Trainees should be preferably from Science background and having working knowledge of English.
- (ii) **Medical & Physical** Should be medically and physically fit in all respect. (No medical to be done at NSG. Person reporting without medical certificate will be RTU)

(iii) **Discipline.** No red Ink entry/ Punishments or held guilty on any disciplinary ground.

(iv) **Language.** Should know either English or Hindi.

(c) **Other Requirements**

(i) Should be a volunteer.

(ii) Conversant with use of service explosives.

(iii) Mentally alert and physically fit.

(iv) Should be BD Basic Course Qualified conducted by NSG or from any recognised Trg Institutions of State Police Forces/CAPF/Army/Navy/Air Force & Preferably with I grading and recommended for Advance BD Course from recognised Police/CAPF/Defence establishment.

(d) **Preference to Personnel Having/ Qualified on.**

(i) Individuals posted as trainers in Training Schools/ Institutions.

(ii) Served in LWE & Counter Insurgency Operations.

(iii) Trainees recommended for Advance course during Basic Course should be detailed preferably.

6. **Screening Test.** An initial screening test will be conducted on the **first day of first week** to judge the learning skills of Trainee. Subsequent to qualifying in screening test, candidates will undergo course. Those failing in the screening test will be RTU.

7. **Methodology of Training.** The training will be of advanced nature, wherein emphasis will be on Render Safe Procedure Drills, Disposals and Post Blast Investigation. The training will be mostly practical in nature.

8. **Pre Course Training.** All trainees should have undergone one week pre course training in CIED aspects at their respective units/ Institutions to achieve requisite standards and should be in possession of 'Qualified' certificate.

9. **Work Schedule.** There will be six working days in a week and nine periods of 60 minutes duration daily. Night classes will be held once a week.

10. **Qualifying/ Passing Standard.** Aim of the course is to impart advance training in bomb/ IED disposal to the instructors of various security agencies and bomb technicians of various bomb disposal squads. The standards to be achieved are as under :-

12. **Grading System.** Grading system will be as under :-

(a) **Instructor Grading.** For award of an instructor grading, a student should fulfil the following QRs:-

- (i) **A'I'** Should score min 70 % in overall written test and have 'A' grading.
- (ii) **B'I'** Should score min 60 % in overall written test and have 'B' grading.
- (iii) The Instructor grading is given to outstanding trainees who perform exceeding well in various tests during the course which encompass written test, practical, explosion analysis and many miscellaneous aspects.

(b) The trainee being considered for an instructor grading should fulfil the following criterion :-

- (i) Min 70% marks in theory.
- (ii) Min 65 % marks in practical.
- (iii) Min 75% marks in IP.
- (iv) Should have good oratory skills.
- (v) High standard of discipline and moral ethics.

13. Reason for Return To Unit (RTU).

- (a) Not Meeting Qualitative Requirements.
- (b) Fail in Tests
- (c) Discipline.
- (d) Medical Unfit.
- (e) If trainees do not produce 'Medical Fitness Certificate' within 48 hrs after reporting to Trg Centre, NSG.
- (f) Missing more than 10% (03 Days) of trg.

14. Practical Tests. Practical tests will be conducted at the end of each phase. Final practical will be conducted for 80 marks in which 30 marks will be allocated to three skill tests (10 marks each) & 50 marks will be allocated for final exercise.

Administrative Aspects.

15. Documentation. All trainees will carry Identity Card, medical certificate signed by Medical Officer, willingness certificate, Last Ration Certificate, Move order, five passport size photographs in uniform and pre-course certificate duly attested by Unit OC.

16. Control Stores. Personal Weapons/ Ammunitions or control stores like Prismatic Compass should **not** be brought by trainee reporting for Bomb Disposal Course.

17. Clothing and Equipment. Details of the clothing and equipment required to be brought by each trainee is as under:-

(b) Private Clothing. Each trainee should carry sufficient private clothing according to prevalent weather conditions.

18. Arrival & Departure. Trainees will report at least 24 hr prior to the commencement of the course. Trainees can depart to their organisation on the next day after completion of the course.

19. **Administrative Staff.** Teams are requested to bring follower staff to manage Administration, Mess & Maintenance of the living area as per following details:-

20. **Mess Advance.** If trainee is not carrying LRC he will have to deposit a mess advance of ₹ 3000/- on arrival, which will later be adjusted against their expenditure on messing during the course.

21. **Last Ration Certificate (LRC)** All trainees from Defence services should bring their Last Ration Certificate (LRC) or official letter from their unit/ organisation stating that the trainee is eligible to be issued rations in kind.

22. **Leave.** No leave will be granted during the course except on compassionate grounds. Trainees missing 10% of working days of training, for any reason, will be RTU. Parent department must ensure that trainees detailed on courses are not recalled for court evidences, departmental courses and other such duties during the course.

23. **Vehicles.** Trainees attending the course are strictly not allowed to bring their personal vehicles & keep their personal vehicle during the duration of the course.

24. **Family.** No trainees are allowed to bring any family member during the course.

25. **Mess Maintenance Allowance.** For the duration of the Course, Mess Maintenance Allowance with respect to Army Officers will be claimed by Training Centre. A certificate to this effect will be brought by the Officer from respective unit (No MMA will be claimed by the unit during the duration of the course).

26. **Feedback.**

(a) A feedback regarding suitable employment of trainees post termination of course from their respective States/ Organisation is required in following format :-
